Landscape Techniques: Fusible (Raw Edge) Applique

Saturday, April 13th 10 am - 3 pm

Taught by Michelle. \$20

This technique for creating a fabric landscape uses fusible web to create the various pieces of the landscape. Each piece is cut individually and then layered with other pieces to create trees, flowers, buildings, etc. For this class, you can choose your own design to work on during class.

Creative Coloring

Saturday, May 18th 10 am to 12 pm

Taught by Michelle. \$10

Learn how to use colored pencils on fabric to color designs or enhance hand embroidery. Color pencils offer more control of the color and design than crayons and have almost a watercolor look when done. This technique can be combined with embroidery to enhance the stitching or used to transform commercial fabric into something uniquely yours.
