

Acorn Crisp

19 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

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Materials:

Fabric A (center triangles): Fat Eighth
 Fabric B (Small center triangles): Fat Eighth
 Fabric C (Large center triangles): Fat Eighth
 Fabric D (Sashing/Outer Border): 1/3 Yard
 Fabric E (Narrow border, Corner triangles, Binding): 1/3 Yard
 Backing: 2/3 Yard
 Batting: 22" x 22"

Wool:

Red/Orange: 1 ~ 8" x 8" of each color
 Brown (acorn cap): 8" x 8"
 Brown (acorn body): 7" x 7"

Extras:

Clearly Perfect Angles- suggested
 Light weight fusible web
 Embroidery Floss

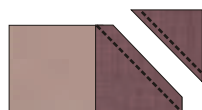
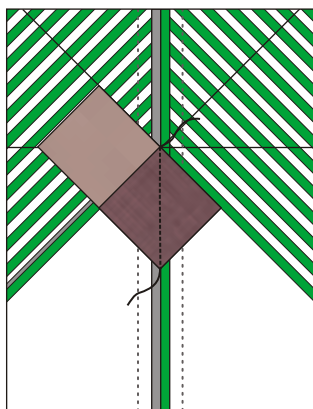


Cutting:

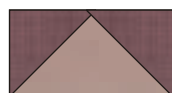
Color A: 8 ~ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
 Color B: 16 ~ 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares
 Color C: 16 ~ 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares
 Color D: 2 ~ 4 1/2" x 19 1/2" rectangles
 2 ~ 4 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangles
 4 ~ 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
 Color E: 4 ~ 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares
 2 ~ 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangles
 2 ~ 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles
 1 ~ 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" square
 2 1/4" strips to equal 90"

Construction:

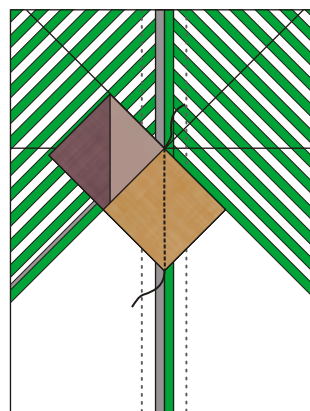
1. Sew Color B square to Color A rectangle on the diagonal from point to point (use center alignment) as illustrated. Trim seam to 1/4". Press.



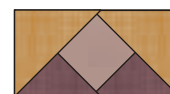
Repeat on other side.

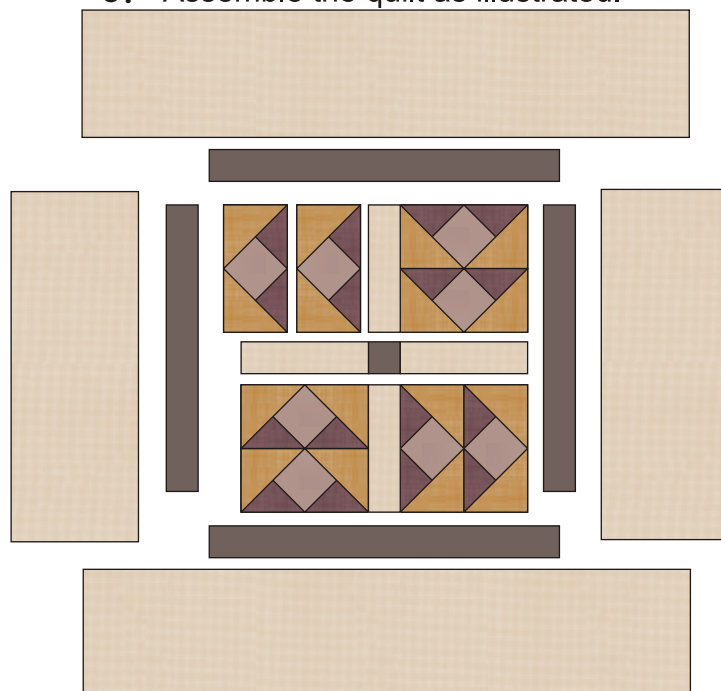


2. Using the same technique, sew Color C squares to each side of Flying Geese sets. Be mindful of which direction you are stitching.

3. Assemble the quilt as illustrated.



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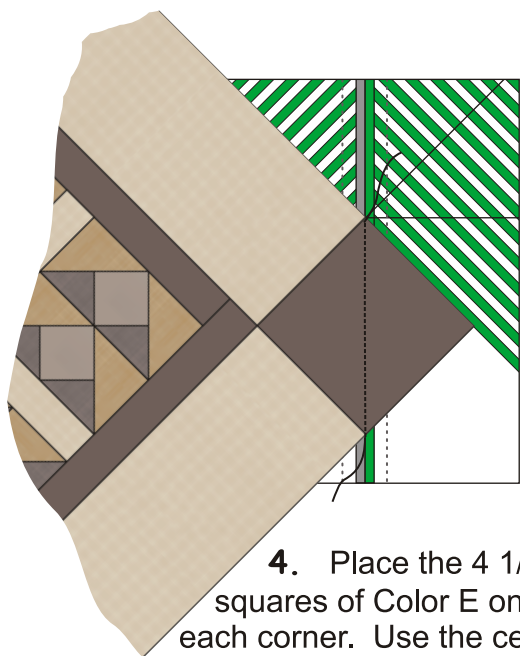
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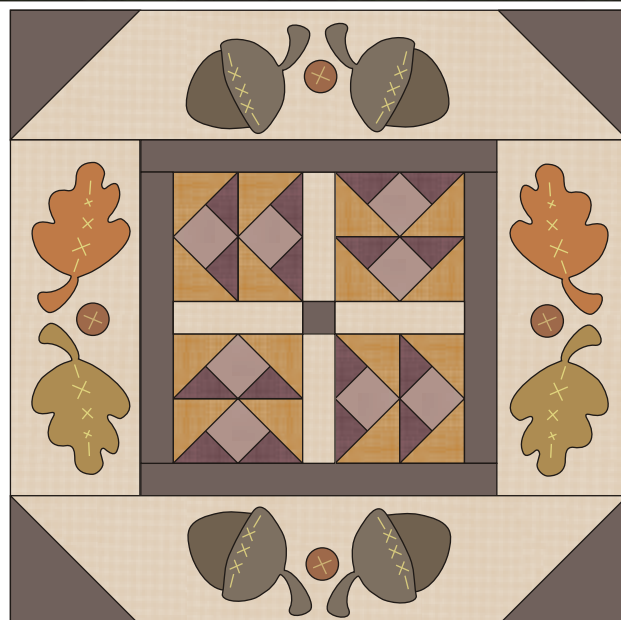
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4. Place the 4 1/2" squares of Color E on each corner. Use the center alignment on the CPA to sew from corner to corner on the diagonal. Trim the seam to 1/4" and press.

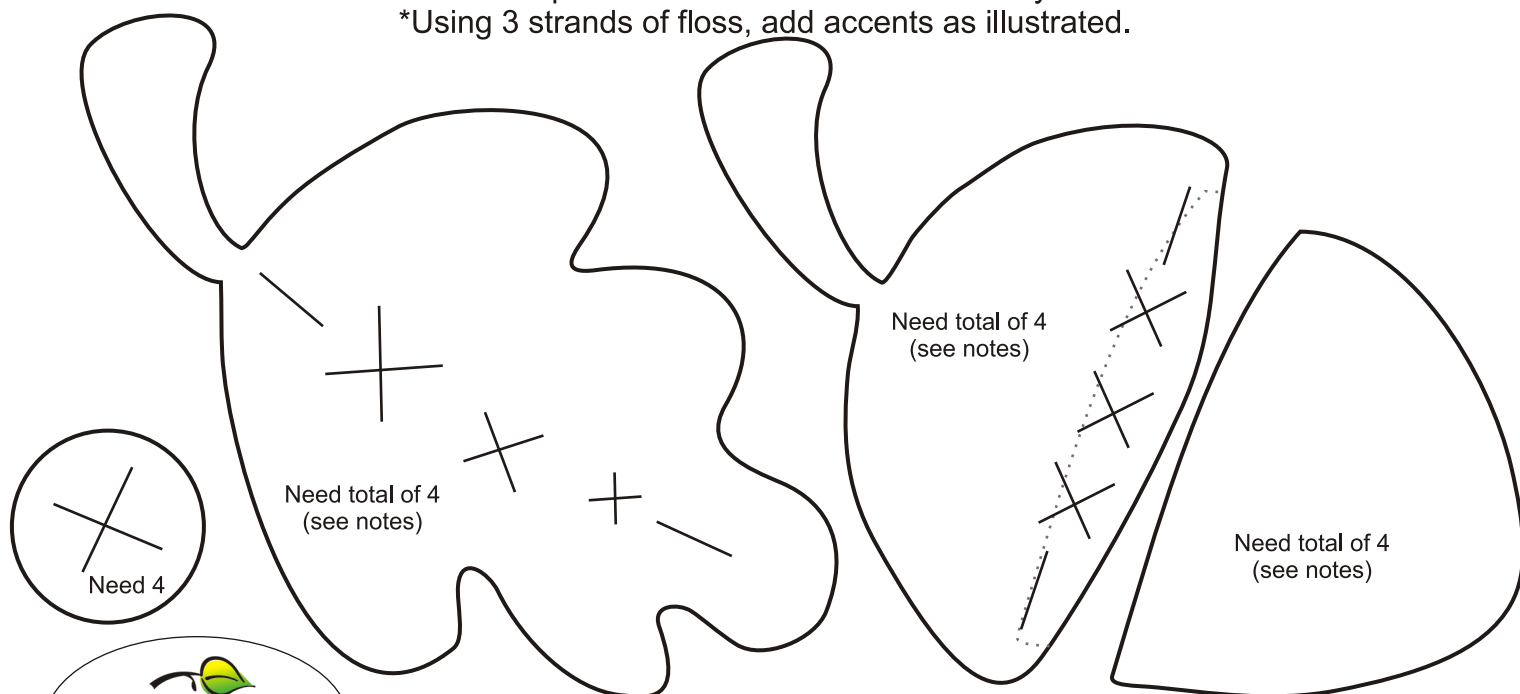


5. Fuse the appliques to quilt. Stitch in place with method of choice. Using contrasting floss, stitch accents on appliques.

6. Quilt & bind as desired.

Wool Applique:

- *Following manufacturer's instructions, trace the templates on the fusible web.
- *Trace 2 leaves and 2 acorns as illustrated. Reverse templates and trace 2 more.
- *Carefully cut out on the traced line.
- *Fuse into place and stitch with machine or by hand.
- *Using 3 strands of floss, add accents as illustrated.



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
