30" x 30"

Yardage

Peach Print (baskets, ribbon border, binding)	1/2 yard
Black Tone-on-Tone (background, borders)	2/3 yard
Red Tone-on-Tone (inner border)	fat eighth
Blue (border)	fat eighth

Cutting (for borders only)

Black Tone-on-Tone:

2 strips, 3" x 29 1/2"
 2 strips, 3" x 24 1/2"
 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 21 1/2"
 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 17 1/2"
 56 squares, 2" x 2"
 2 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Red Tone-on-Tone:

2 strips, 1 1/2" x 14 1/2"
 2 strips, 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Peach Print:



28 rectangles, 2" x 3 1/2"
 2 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
 Binding strips

Blue:


2 strips, 2" x 17 1/2"
 2 strips, 2" x 14 1/2"

Ribbon Border

Using the basic center alignment on the **Clearly Perfect Angles***, sew a 2" black square to each end of the peach 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles diagonally from point to point. Trim seam allowances and press. Please note the two different variations needed.






Yield: 14

Using the gray band alignment on the **Clearly Perfect Angles***, sew a 2 1/2" black square to a 2 1/2" peach square 1/4" on both sides of center. Cut apart between stitched seams and press.



Yield: 4

Sew the units together as illustrated and press seams open.

Yield: 2

Assemble the Topper

Sew the borders to the appliqued center as illustrated. Press.

Quilt as desired and add binding.

Enjoy!


