Supplies: Cat Mountain Fiber Arts Fusion Yarn, One 750-yard, 12-ounce skein Us Size 9 Circular Needle, 36 inch or longer

Abbreviations:

K2tog – Knit 2 together YO – Yarn over

Cast on 292 Stitches.

Row 1: Knit all stitches Row 2: Purl all stitches Row 3: Knit first 2 stitches; K2tog three times; \*YO, K1, six times, K2tog six times\* repeat from \* to \* fourteen times; YO, K1 six times, K2tog three times, Knit last 2 stitches. Row 4: Knit all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until the wrap is the desired length or you run out of yarn, ending with Row 4, and casting off purlwise.

The sample wrap was knit as described above. You may decrease or increase the width by subtracting or adding stitches in multiples of 18.

Each 18 stitch repeat, using the yarn and needle size described herein results in a width of approximately 4 to 5 inches. The Sample Garment is shown in the colorway "Mallard"
