This could be a cowl, or it can be the longest “infinity scarf” you’ve ever made!
This 18-row pattern repeat is easy to memorize and can be repeated as many
times as you want to create a unique accessory!

Materials:
DK weight Yarn
Size “F” crochet hook
Darning needle
Scissors

Abbreviations:
CH- chain
SC- single crochet
DC- double crochet
FPDC- front post double crochet
FPTR- front post treble crochet
ST(S)- stitch(es)
RS- right/front side
WS- wrong/back side

Gauge: Individual gauge may vary.

Notes:

- Turning CH 3 counts as the first stitch of all odd numbered rows.
- All fptr are worked around the fpdc/fptr of the previous right side row.

Pattern:

CH 43, skip first 3 ch, dc in 4th chain from hook and each chain across (41 dc), ch 3, turn.

Row 1: (RS) [dc, fpdc] 2 times, dc 14, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 14, [fpdc, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 2 and All Even Numbered Rows: (WS) sc in each st across, ch 3, turn. (41 sts)

Row 3: [dc, fptr] 2 times, dc 11, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 3, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 11, [fptr, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 5: [dc, fptr] 2 times, dc 8, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 9, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 8, [fptr, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 7: [dc, fptr] 2 times, dc 5, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 15, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 5, [fptr, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 9: [dc, fptr] 2 times, dc 2, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 21, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 2, [fptr, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 11: Repeat row 9.

Row 13: [dc, fptr] 2 times, dc 5, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 15, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 5, [fptr, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 15: [dc, fptr] 2 times, dc 8, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 9, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 8, [fptr, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 17: [dc, fptr] 2 times, dc 11, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 3, ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc 11, [fptr, dc] 2 times, dc 1, ch 1, turn.

Row 18: sc in each st across, ch 3, turn.

Repeat rows 1- 18 to desired length, changing the FPDC to FPTR when repeating row 1.

End project by working row 1 one more time, omitting final ch 1, turn. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Finishing: fold project in half, front sides together, whip stitch beginning row to final row, and turn right-side out. Weave in ends and block to finish.



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“CELEBRATE” Cowl

Size: Approximately 42” around x 7” wide

Materials: 200-250 yards DK weight yarn; 36”-40” size 6 circular needle;
stitch markers.

Gauge: 4 ½ sts=1” in pattern

NOTES:

- Several very good videos demonstrating the Moebius cast on method can be found on YouTube.
- All measurements and gauge are listed as approximate. Your measurements will be determined by the yarn you use. (Can be made in any yarn you choose.)
- Because of the construction method used, if you add or subtract stitches from the cast on or pattern repeats, the number is doubled. For example, if you cast on 6 stitches less you will actually be decreasing the number of working stitches by 12.
- Cowl can be made longer or shorter by adding or deleting stitches in multiples of 6 sts. *Remember*: this will change the amount of yarn needed.
- Width can also be increased by working additional pattern repeats.

COWL:

With size 6 circular needle and using Moebius Method, cast on 150 stitches (this creates 300 working stitches).

Place marker for beginning of round. Purl one round then begin working Small Diamond pattern as follows:

Row 1: *K2 tog, yo, k4; repeat from * around.

Row 2 and all alternate rows: Purl.

Row 3: Move beg of row marker one stitch to the left; *yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2 tog; repeat from * around.

Row 5: *K3, yo, k3 togtbl, yo; repeat from * around.

Row 7: *K3, k2 tog, yo, k1; repeat from * around.

Row 9: Move beginning of row marker one stitch to the right; *ssk, k1, k2 tog, yo, k1, yo; repeat from * around.

Row 11: *Yo, k3 togtbl, yo, k3; repeat from * around.

Row 12: Purl

Repeat these 12 rows to desired width. Bind off using a stretchy bind off method. Block and enjoy.
