# Alice Capelet by Christianna Frenette-Bowland

Designed to be worn as a cowl or over the shoulders.

### Materials:

Theodora's Pearls Auxanometer DK, 270 yards/115gm skein

3 colors of Theodora's Pearls Auxanometer DK: 50 grams of color A Lemon, 100

grams of color B Papaya, and color C Acme

Colors shown in example: Lemon, Papaya, Acme

Size H hook, or hook needed to obtain gauge

2 locking stitch markers

Scissors

Darning needle

Gauge: 4 stitches per inch, 3 rounds per inch

## Abbreviations:

CH- chain

ST(S)- stitch(es)

Slp st- slip stitch

SC- single crochet

DC- double crochet

INC- increase (2 double crochets in the same st)



#### Notes:

When working in the round, the ch 3 or ch 2 at the beginning of the round counts as the first st of that round. In the color change sections, ch 4 at the beginning of the round counts as the first dc of that round plus a ch 1. Move markers up in every round.

Odd number rounds are the right-side rounds.

#### Pattern:

With color A ch 101, skip first ch, sc in each remaining st across (100 sts). Join in the round to first sc with a slp st, ch 3.

Round 1: dc in each st around, join with slp st in the third ch of the ch 3. Ch 3, turn.

Round 2: repeat round 1.

Round 3: dc 25, place marker in last st made, dc 50, place marker in last st made, dc in remaining 25 sts, join, ch 3, turn.

Round 4: dc to one st before marker, inc in next st, dc in next st, move marker to st just made, inc in next st, dc to one st before marker, inc in next st, dc in next st, move marker to st just made, inc in next st, dc to end of round, join, ch 3, turn. (104 sts)

Round 5: repeat round 1, ch 4 at end of round, turn.

Round 6: skip first st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] around. Drop color A. Using color B, slp st in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of the starting ch 4, ch 3, turn.

<u>Round 7</u>: dc into skipped st 2 rounds below, [ch 1, skip next st, dc into skipped st 2 rows below] around. Drop color B. Using color A, slp st join, ch 4, turn.

Round 8: [dc in skipped st 2 rounds below, ch 1, skip next st] around. Break color A. Using color B, slp st in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of the starting ch 4, ch 2, turn.

Round 9: [dc in skipped st 2 rows below, sc in dc] around. Join, ch 3, turn.

Rounds 10-11: repeat Round 1.

Round 12 (increase round): [dc until 2 sts before marker, inc in the next 2 sts, dc in next st, inc in next 2 sts] two times, dc in remaining sts, join, ch 3, turn. (112 sts)



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Rounds 13-15: repeat round 1.

Round 16: repeat round 12. (120 sts)

Rounds 17-19: repeat round 1.

Round 20: repeat round 12. (128 sts)

Rounds 21-23: repeat round 1.

Round 24: repeat round 3, join, ch 4, turn. (136 sts)

<u>Round 25</u>: skip first dc, [dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc] around. Drop color B. Using color C, slp st in ch 3 of the beginning ch 4, ch 3, turn.

Round 26: [dc in skipped st 2 rows below, ch 1, skip next dc] around until 2 sts remain, dc in skipped st 2 rows below.

Drop color C. Using color B, slp st join, ch 4, turn.

Round 27: skip first dc, [dc in skipped st 2 rows below, ch 1, skip next dc] around. Break color B. Using color C, slp st in ch 3 of beginning ch 4, ch 2.

Round 28: dc in skipped st 2 rows below, [sc in next dc, dc in skipped st 2 rows below] around. Join, ch 3, turn.

Round 29: repeat round 1.

Round 30: repeat round 12. (144 sts)

Rounds 31-33: repeat round 1.

Round 34: repeat round 12. (152 sts)

Rounds 35-37: repeat round 1.

Round 38: repeat round 12. (160 sts)

Rounds 39-41: repeat round 1.

Round 42: repeat round 12. (168 sts)

Round 43: repeat round 1, join, ch 1, do not turn.

Round 44: reverse sc in each st around, join, finish off.

## Finishing:

Using tail at the beginning of the capelet, sew the first sc to the last sc of the establishing row and weave in the rest of the tail. Weave in remaining tails, block, and enjoy your capelet!
