Binding Your Quilt

Date(s) : Saturday, May 20 _____ Time: 1:30 – 3:30 pm

You need:

- Quilt to Bind (if no quilt, bring an 18" square sandwich)
- Enough fabric to make bias binding for your quilt (ask a Close to Home associate) or an 18" square of any fabric
- Marker that shows on your binding fabric
- The longest ruler you own: Creative Grid's 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" "Quilters' Select 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" (great addition to your collection)
- Thread to match your binding: I prefer 100% Silk Finish Cotton #414-0576 Monofilament Thread, clear
- Kwik Clips or binding clips (the more the merrier)
- Cut Rite Binding Tool

Pre-Class Work:

- Finish Quilting your current project
- Baste each side individually by hand or machine; knot on one edge and leave long thread tails on the opposite edge

Also, bring the following:

- Sewing machine in top running condition*
- Presser Feet: Walking/Dual Feed/Even Feed and all the soles you have
- Any seam guides
- Needles: New #80/12
- Scissors: Sharp cutting shears and thread snips or small scissors
- Hand sewing needles
