Come join us in making these easy to sew cases to protect your scissors and rotary cutters. Also great for protecting other sewing notions, pencils, make up brushes, and so much more. Each case uses a minimum amount of fabric and interfacing. The pattern gives instruction for making 3 different sizes and comes together quickly. The pattern is easy to customize to different sizes besides the 3 provided. We will talk about different ways to finish your cases in class.

Fabric (regardless of the size you choose):

- 1/8 yard for outside of the case
- 1/8 yard for lining of the case

Supplies:

- Casey Quick Cases Pattern (CTH# 308308)
- 1/8 yard Décor Bond (CTH# 809)
- ¼ yard Steam-a-Seam Lite 2 (CTH# 5440) OR Heat n Bond Lite (CTH# 3521)
- Frixion Pen (CTH# 612)
- Straight Pins
- Wonder Clips
- Small Iron/ Wool Mat
- Microtex (Sharp) Needles 80/12 OR 90/14
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Thread to match project
- Small Cutting Mat & Rotary Blade
- Small Ruler (I like the Creative Grids 2 ½" X 12 ½")
- Scissors
- Hair Elastic to close your case

Pre-Class Work:

READ THROUGH AND FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THE PATTERN. CUT A 3 ½" BY WIDTH OF FABRIC STRIP FROM BOTH FABRICS AND BOTH STABILIZERS (you will need (2) 3 ½" strips of the steam-a-seam lite or the heat 'n' bond lite). Make a copy of the Bottom Edge Curve Template (found in your pattern).
