Supplies Needed:

1 or 2 Jelly Rolls (see chart below)

Studio 180 Design's Star 60® Tool (13780000221)

Invisi-Grip (560822)

Machine piecing needle: Microtex 70/10 for batiks, Universal 80/12 for quilters cottons

Mettler Metrosene piecing thread (9161)

Rotary Cutter with NEW ROTARY BLADE and cutting mat

sewing machine in good working order

¼" presser foot for piecing

Scissors, seam ripper, pins, wonder clips & typical sewing supplies

Optional but handy: iron and pressing mat

Fabric	Crib/Toddler	Throw
Assorted Lights, Mediums, and Darks	12 – 2 ½" strips of each value (1 Jelly Roll)	24 – 2 ½" strips of each value (2 Jelly Rolls)
Background and Borders	¾ yard	1 yard
Binding	½ yard	2/3 yard
Backing	2 ¾ yards	4 1/8 yards
