The Designs we are doing in the first class are approximately 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" Finished. Please bring the Hoop that is large enough to accommodate this size design. *

Cut the Main Background Fabric large enough to fit your hoop. I recommend adding an additional 4" to the outer hoop size. For secure hooping, fuse Shape Flex Fusible Woven Interfacing to the entire back of the fabric. You will need a total of Eight pieces for the large designs. Bring at least Two pieces that have been fused and cut to size to the First Class.

Prepare Applique Pieces for Bouquet & One Large Block. Select the applique fabrics and fuse Shape Flex Fusible Woven Interfacing to the back (wrong side) of the fabrics. Label Fabrics for each design. Use numbered pins or clips to keep the pieces for each design together.

An Empty 16 gig (or smaller) USB stick that will be Dedicated to this Project. Copy the designs for your machine (format & hoop size) onto the stick.*

Approximately 7 Yards of Main Background Fabric & 3-4 yards for Contrast Background

1/8-1/4 yard of Fabrics for Appliques (FQ also work)

Pressing Cloth

505 glue stick and 505 Spray

4 1/2" x 12" or 4 1/2" x 18" Creative Grids or Quilter's Select Ruler for trimming & centering the border blocks

Applique Scissors – Heritage Cutlery Duckbill or Karen Kay Buckley Red Curved are recommended

Chaco liner for marking centers of blocks in a color that will show on your background

Fusible Woven or Shape Flex Interfacing: About 10 yards if 20" wide (to back all embroideries)

Basic Quilting supplies for cutting & trimming the blocks:

Cutting mat & Rotary Cutter

6 1/2" or 8 1/2" x 24 1/2" Quilters Select or Creative Grids Long Ruler

6 1/2" & 12 1/2" Quilters Select or Creative Grids Square rulers for Trimming,

A Variety of Embroidery Threads to coordinate with your applique fabrics

Embroidery Needles (size 75/11 or 80/12)

Several Bobbins filled with Bobbin Thread appropriate for your machine

OESD Ultra Clean & Tear Stabilizer

Numbered/Lettered Pins or Clips (ABC Cool Pins, Magic Lettered/Numbered Pins or Alpha Clippies)

Embroidery Machine in top working condition, embroidery foot, cord & hoops:

This project uses multiple sizes of embroidery hoops. Minimum hoop sizes without re-hooping:

Bernina Hoops Jumbo or Giant (Maxi for re-hooping)

Viking Hoops 260x465 or 260x360

Babylock/Brother Hoops 9 1/2" x 14"

Additional hoop sizes are also useful

A Multi-spool holder for your embroidery machine is Optional but Helpful

Also a Wool Pressing Mat is Helpful to Prevent Crushing the Embroideries while ironing
