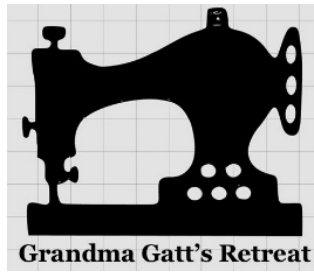

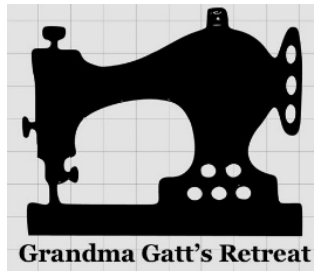

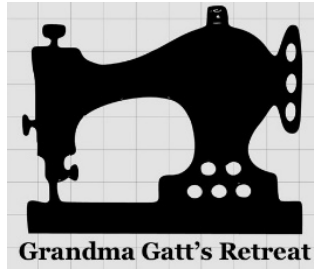
Machine(s): Sewing, Serging, Embroidering (embroidery module and hoops)

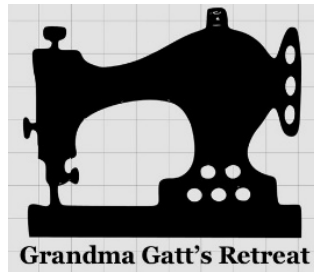
