



## Jelly Roll Rug

Turn a jelly roll into a functional area rug. Selecting your fabric is easy – the jelly roll does all the work!

### Fabrics:

- One jelly roll (makes a 30" x 44" oval rug)
- One 50 yard (2 ¼") Bosal Katahdin Batting On-A-Roll (CTH# 390390)
- **Alternative to Batting On-A-Roll – 1 ¼ yds. 90-96" wide cotton batting, cut into 2 ¼" strips**

### Supplies:

- Jelly Roll Rug pattern (CTH# 32549000016)
- Jelly Roll Tube Maker (CTH# 13780000201)
- Batting Seam Tape (if cutting your own batting) (CTH# 5604113)
- Schmetz Jeans Needle 90/14 (CTH# 402058)
- Thread to blend or contrast with your fabric (you will need 1200+ yards)
- Mary Ellen's Best Press (CTH# 560871)

### Also bring the following:

- Sewing machine in good running order
- Walking foot and needle plate for zig-zag stitching
- **An extension table is very helpful for this project. It will prevent your project from curling up by keeping it on a flat working surface.**
- **Small iron and large wool mat is optional but very helpful**

### Pre-Class Work

- Sew your jelly roll strips together end to end as shown in your pattern. Sew them in the order they come in on your jelly roll. Trim the seam allowance and press seams open. Roll onto a tube starting with your INSIDE RUG fabric.
