

Layer the Brights. Trim the Stack to Even-Up the Edges. Cut Two Strips that are 1-3/4" by the Width of the Fabric.




Sew the Strips of Brights Together in Sets of Two. Offset Strips by Approximately 1". Press the Strips to Relax the Stitches. Then Open & Press Seams to One Side




Cut the Pieced Strips into Triangles at the 3" Quarter Square Triangle Line on the QS 3-in-1 Combo Ruler. Rotate the Ruler as You Cut. You will end up with Four Sets of Four Triangles Each.




Layer the Background Fabrics. Cut Two 3" Strips from Each.





Pick Two Sets of Pieced Triangles. Join the Triangles to the Background Strips. Make Sure to Leave Enough Room Between the Triangles. Hint: Use an "Extra" Triangle to Gauge Positioning.





Cut 6-1/2 Half Square Triangles from the Strips.







Join the Triangles into Squares,
Alternating Colors.
Make Four Sets



Sew the Units
Together Like a
Four-Patch.
