



Lattice Table Runner

Date(s) Tuesday, June 2, 2026 Time 10:00 am to 2:30 pm

You need:

- Pattern: Lattice Table Runner by Shabby Fabrics.com
- All fabrics as listed on the pattern. It is suggested that you tape a small piece of fabric over the pattern in the “Required Materials” section
- Batting or Pelon Fleece to fit (wait till class to cut)
- Rotary cutter: with a sharp blade (cutting mats are available for class use)
- Plexiglas ruler: 6” or 6 ½” x 24” or 24 ½”, and a shorter one for easier handling
- Sewing Machine in top running condition*, instruction book and all accessories
- ¼” presser foot, Walking/Even Feed/Dual Feed attachment
- Threads: Mettler Metrosene in medium grey for piecing, we will select fabric for machine quilting in class
- New machine needle 80/12 universal, 80/12 sharp or Microtex if using batik
- Assorted Marking tools: Frixion pen, Chaco-Liner, Ultimate Marking Pencil
- Scissors: small sharp, thread snippers
- Pins: long quilters’ with flat heads or balls, Quilting Klips

Before Class:

Optional: Prewash fabrics

Bigger pieces in the machines like a blouse or shirt, remove from dryer while damp and hang over a “pants hanger”. Smaller pieces, rinse in the sink and air dry

Cut all fabric as directed on your pattern. It is suggested that you indicate the individual sections by “Klipping” the assigned letter to the pack as you cut
