



**Use a Square Squared
Ruler to Cut the Colored
Fabrics into Squares that
are the Correct Size for
4" Finished Block.**

Sew Two Green Squares to Two of the Dark Purple



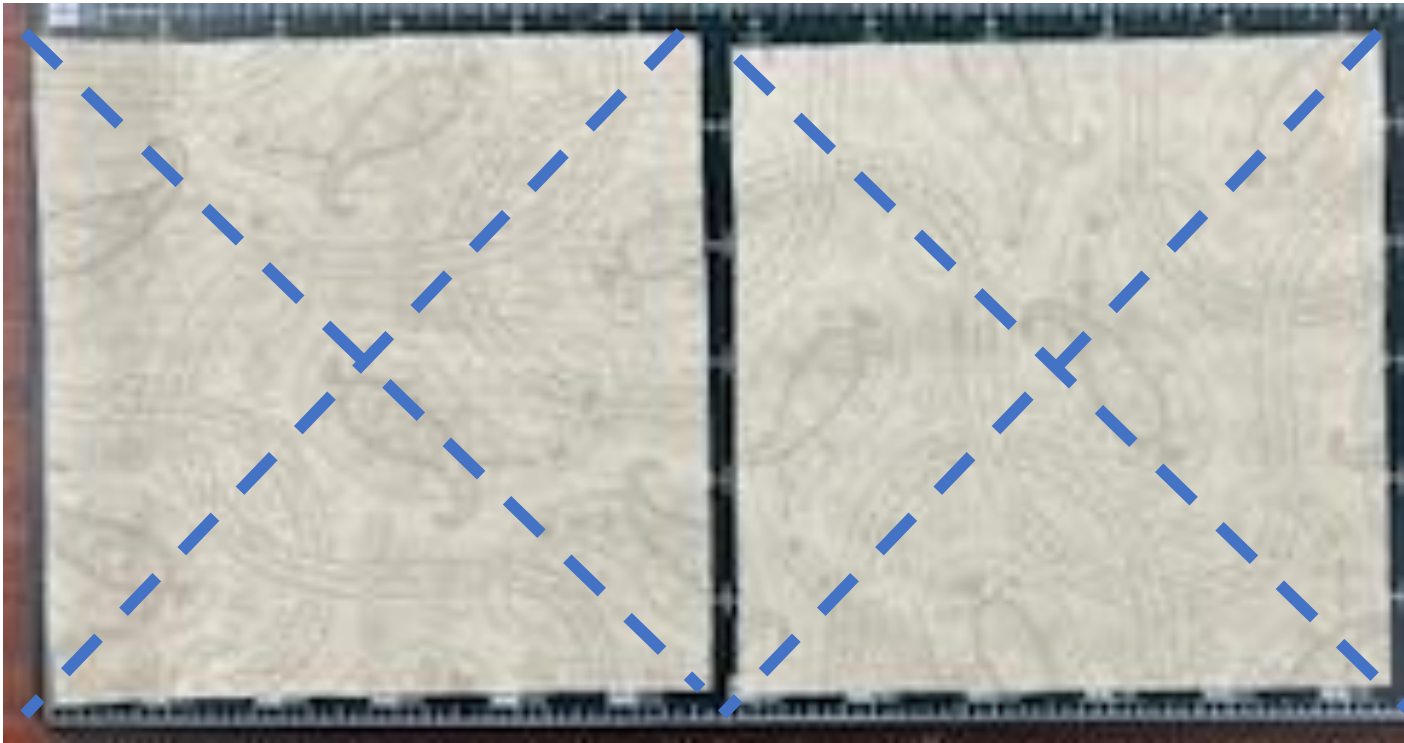
Sew a Light Purple Square to the Other Two Dark Purple Squares.



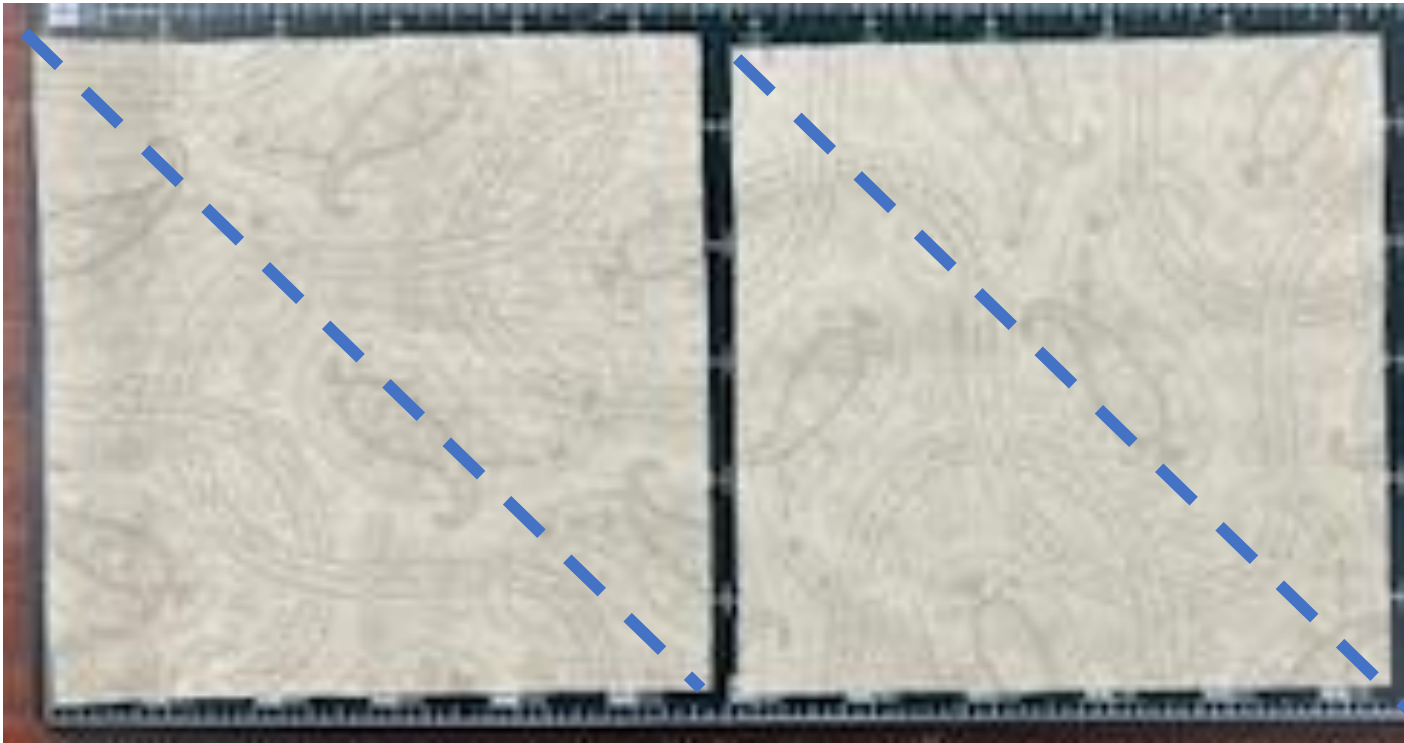
**Sew the Purple Pairs to Opposite Sides of the
Yellow Center Square**



Cut the Background Fabric into Two 5-3/4" Squares. Then Cut Them Twice Diagonally Like an "X" to Make Quarter Square Triangles. They are Oversized.



**Also Cut the Background Fabric into Two
4.5" Squares. Then Cut Them Once
Diagonally to Make the Corner Triangles.
They are Oversized.**

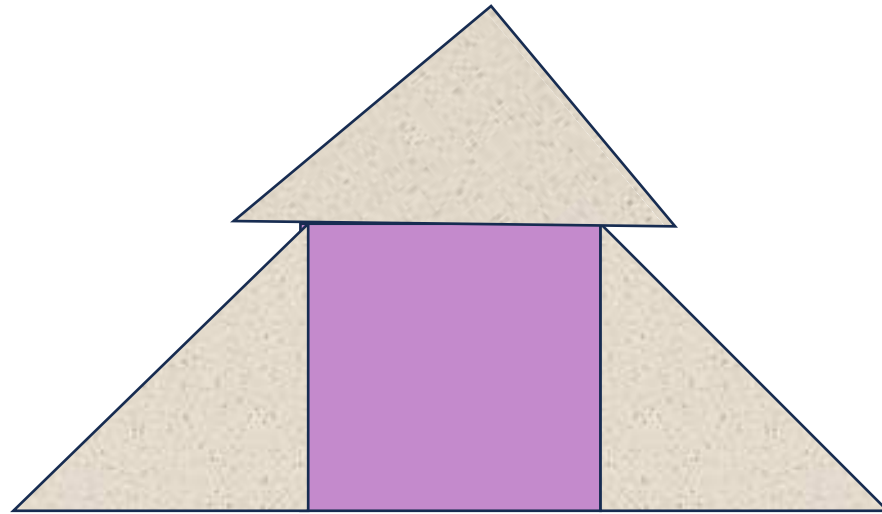


**Add Half Square Triangles to Each
End of the Center Unit.**



**Sew a Set of Background Quarter Square Triangles to
Two Sides of the Remaining Light Purple Squares.**

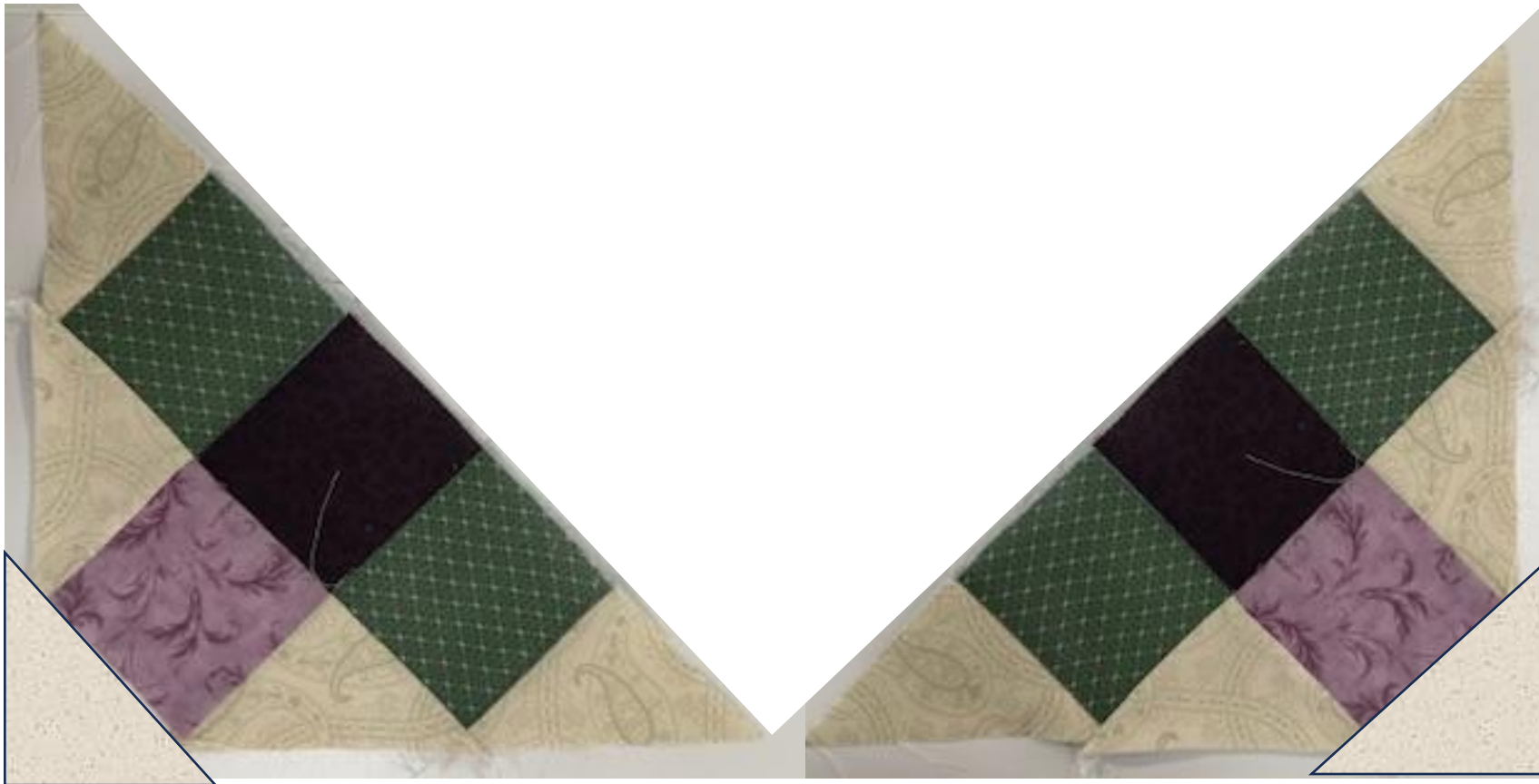
Add An Oversized Half Square Triangle to Each



**Add Quarter Square Triangles to the Ends
of Each of the Green/Purple Units.**



**Join Light Purple/Background Units to
Green/Dark Purple Units. Make 2 Sets**





**Join the Rows &
Trim to 12-1/2".**
