

## **Pole Twist Table Runner**

Date: Tuesday, August 4, 2026

### **You need:**

Directions for the runner as seen online: [www.vikisfabriccreations.com](http://www.vikisfabriccreations.com)  
Fabrics and batting/fleece as directed by the pattern  
Thread for piecing: 100% polyester: Mettler Metroscene in medium grey  
Thread for quilting: 100% cotton: Sulky Blendables, Mettler Silk Finish  
Rotary cutter with a sharp blade  
Plexiglas ruler: 6" or 6 ½" x 24" or 24 ½", and a shorter one for convenience  
Sewing Machine in top condition\*, instruction book and all accessories  
¼" presser foot for piecing, walking/even feed/dual feed for quilting  
New machine needle 80/12 universal, sharps if using batik  
Marking tools: Frixion pen, Clover Chaco-Liner, Ultimate Marking Pencil  
Scissors: small sharp, thread snippers  
Pins: long quilters' with flat heads or balls  
Small sharp quilters' safety pins for basting  
Quilters' Klips

**The colors on the directions are Red, Green and White. When you select fabric, designate which fabric goes in each position: twist, pole and background**

### **Before Class:**

Follow directions for "Method 1"  
Cut 15 @ 5" squares of Twist Fabric  
Cut 5 @ 5" squares of Pole Fabric  
Cut 10 @ 5" squares of Background Fabric

Do not cut borders or binding fabrics before class

There will be a 30 minute break; bring lunch or snack if desired
