



## Quilted Patchwork Stocking

A fun scrap busting quilted stocking!

### Supplies Needed:

Cut Loose Press Quilted Patchwork Stocking Pattern (CTH#12002)

Creative Grids Crazy 6 Templates Quilt Ruler (CTH#89515145)

Assorted Prints to make blocks ( you can make as scrappy as you want or stick to just a few colors)\*

- **Pattern uses 5 colors and yardage requirements are listed on the pattern, don't forget the batting, lining and backing fabric!!!!** I took the scrappy road!

For Cuff 11" x 20" piece ( you will be quilting this so you need batting and backing to match the 11" x 20" piece) you have options! You can use lace trim as I did in one of the samples, but you will need a length of at least 20"!

505 Temporary Fabric Adhesive (CTH#200342)

Creative Grids 6 ½ x 6 ½ Square ruler ( CTH#560069) or any ruler that will let you trim to a 6 ½" square

Thread to piece and construct

Variegated top stitching thread for decorative stitches

Machine in good working order with new Schmetz 80/12 Needle- also have on hand Topstitch 90/14 (CTH#3634631783), Quilting Needles (CTH#402054) and if using Metallic Decorative

Thread you need to use Metallic Needle 80/12 (CTH#3634631743)

Rotary Cutter, Cutting Surface, scissors, pins, seam ripper

Optional but nice to have: Small iron and ironing surface!

**Pre-Class Work- Please familiarize yourself with the pattern and have all your supplies ready to go!! You will need to enlarge the stocking pattern, which you will get online! Just follow the directions on the front of your pattern—I went to Staples and had it done there!!**

Supplies available at Close to Home
