

Serger Workshop – Trendy Fringe Tote

Date(s)Saturday, June 14, 2025Time10 am to 3:30 pm(1/2 hour lunch break)

You need:

Pattern: Trendy Fringe Tote by Barbara Goldkorn

Fabric: Main print for outside of bag (1/2 yard)

Solid Cotton – ½ Yard

Lining: Cotton Fabric (2/3 yard)

Soft and Stable: 2/3 Yard

Heat and Bond Light – 1 Yard

Thread: 4 Cones Serger thread (Color to coordinate with fabric)

Thread: 1 Spool Wonderfil Spaghetti or Floriani 12 wt thread in color of choice for fringe **Thread:** Fusible thread

Also, bring the following:

Serger/Overlock machine in top running condition* with instruction book, power cord, foot control, and all accessories that came with the machine
Scissors: Small scissors for clipping needle thread, be sure the tip is sharp
Seam Ripper: Just in case
Best Press
Rotary Cutter, Mat, Ruler
Marker that shows on your solid fabric
Wonder Clips, any size and/or Straight Pins

Pre Class Preparation: Performing these steps saves class time so you'll get further with your project

Follow directions on the CUT LIST and FABRIC PREPARATION Look over the MARKING information to determine good placement of the detailed embellishments Don't have chain stitch capability? Bring your sewing machine or use one of our classroom models to stitch the straight lines

30 minute break: bring lunch or snack

CUT LIST:

- Main print Outside of bag: ½ Yard
 Cut 2- 16" X 18"
- Cotton for Lining 2/3 Yard
 - Cut 2-20" X 18" Lining
 - Cut 1- 1 1/8" X 45" Handles
- Solid Cotton ½ Yard
 Cut 2-4" X WOF Fringe strip
 Cut 1-2 ¾" X WOF Handles
- Soft ad Stable 2/3 Yard
 Cut 2- 16" X 18" Tote body
 Cut 1- 1 1/8" X WOF Handles
- Heat and Bond lite 1 Yard
 Cut 2- 16 X 18

FABRIC PREPARATION:

- Fuse the Heat and Bond lite to the Soft and Stable
- Remove paper from Heat and Bond lite and fuse WRONG side of outside fabric to Soft and Stable

MARKING:

- Place marks, on both front and back panels, at desired direction and spacing based off fabric print and look at what you are wanting for the background of tote.
- Option 1: 2" grid placing stitching lines around the circle pattern of fabric.
- Option 2: 1" Vertical lines on the print. Look at the fabric and stitch what will add detail, remember the real star of this project is the fringe
