Supply List

“Show and Tell” Pattern by Elizabeth Hartman.

We will be making the Small Quilt (45x 57) and constructing the four blocks in this order: Bear, Deer, Bunny & Fox. Please refer to the pattern for fabric requirements. Kona solids or simple tone-on-tone fabrics work well given the small size of the pieces.

Rulers:

6” x 24” QS or Creative Grids Long ruler

8” or larger QS or Creative Grids square

4.5” QS 3-in-1 Combo tool (Easy Angle or CGR Corner Clipper also works)

Other Supplies:

Neutral colored thread for piecing (light grey or beige)

Fabric Scissors

45 mm Quilter’s Select or Olfa rotary cutter with a New Blade

Cutting Mat at least 18” x 24”

Sewing machine in top running condition with a New needle & at least one full bobbin

¼ inch foot appropriate for your sewing machine

Marking tool or pen that shows on your fabrics

AlphaClippies clips

Flatter spray

Basic sewing supplies – pins, seam ripper, snips, extra bobbins & needles, etc.

Personal sized Pressing mat and small iron are optional but helpful

Thank you for coming to class prepared. Supplies available at Close to Home. Students receive 15% discount on Class Supplies & other purchases on class days. Animals:

Bear – 1 fat eighth for bear and one 5x5 for the muzzle (lighter brown than your bear)

Deer – one fat eighth for deer and 5x5 white for antlers

Bunny – 1 fat eighth grey and 10x10 square of pink

Fox – 1 fat eighth for fox and 5x5 white for nose and tail

Eyes and nose – 1/8 yard black or fat quarter

Blocks – choose 4 different colors. Kona solids work well. For each block you will need

Bear – 5 shades of one color (pink in sample) 4 fat eighths, one fat quarter

Deer – 6 shades of one color (Purple in sample) 4 fat eighths, 2 fat quarters

Bunny – 6 shades of one color (teal in sample)- 5 fat eighths, one fat quarter

Fox – 6 shades of one color (green, orange in sample) – 4 fat eighths, 2 fat quarters

(use the pattern to guide your choices and you may have scraps of the correct size for some of the colors)

Background 2 yards

Backing 3 ¼ yards

Binding ½ yard

Batting minimum 49x61
