



Tamarack Jacket Class 1

You need:

Pattern: Tamarack Jacket by Grainline Studio

Fabric: Outer, lining and binding according to size chart on page 3 (if you select a directional fabric, add two repeats to the yardage)

Batting: 100% cotton Quilters Dream Select or Request

Thread: To be decided in class

Pre-Class Work:

Pre-wash all fabric (wash in cold water with a small amount of mild detergent. Remove from the dryer still damp and hang over a “pants hanger”. This reduces the need to iron) no need to wash the batting

Take your measurements to determine which size to make, especially bust and neck to waist (final decision to be made in class). If you feel comfortable, cut the pattern pieces in your size: back, front and sleeves only

Also, bring the following for class One:

“Dress Weights” or five 12oz or larger cans of food

Cloth tape measurer

Pins: Long Sharp Quilting Pins

Scissors: Sharp scissors for cutting several layers

Marking tools: Frixion Pen, Clover Chaco-Liner Pen or the new white marker that irons away (check part number on counter display), it should show on your main fabric

1” Brass Safety Pins for basting

Long Ruler: Creative Grid or Quilters Select 2 ½” x 36 ½”

Your box of sewing machine accessories and feet

***Do not need to bring your sewing machine to the first class**

Thank you for coming to class prepared
