Brief Class Description:

Learn how to make this wall hanging by Buttermilk Basin. There are many different options available in the pattern:

- The sample hanging in the shop is a wall hanging which measures 20" x 48.5". The letters spelling HOME are positioned vertically. It also includes the half-square triangle inner border. The letters spelling HOME can also be positioned horizontally if desired.
- You can also make a slightly smaller version without the half-square triangle inner border. This version measures 13.5" x 34.5". The letters spelling HOME can also be positioned either vertically or horizontally.
- The third version is a small round, circular mat that is 9" round. It is made by using the letter O and has a scalloped border.
- Any of the versions may be made into a pillow, if desired.

Monthly-themed center circle mats are created for each month, using the applique method of your choice.

Originally, this pattern was made with wool, but the sample was made using cotton fabric and it works equally well.

Monthly Circle Fabric Requirements:

For all 12 circles:

0	Cream (Background on front of circle)	1 yard
0	Backing for circles	1 yard
0	Décor Bond (stiffening for inside circles)	1 vard

- Batting (to back circle while doing embroidery 12- 8.5" square pieces
 Small pieces of various colors depending upon design (see patterns)
- o Thread to match colors in design for applique
- Steam-A-Seam Light (CTH #5440)
 About 3 yards
- o Buttons or beads for embellishment

Tools:

- Light box for tracing applique shapes onto the Steam-A-Seam Light
- Iron for setting applique shapes onto the circles

Miscellaneous:

- Mettler Metrosene (CTH # 9161) thread for piecing
- 12 Large snaps (CTH #80211) or Velcro to attach circles to the wall hanging

Pre-Class Work:

Wash and iron fabric if desired.

For class, please bring the following:

Sewing machine in top running condition*

Presser Feet: 1/4" foot for piecing

Needles: Universal

Scissors

Rotary cutter, 45 mm (CTH # 8921115)

Rulers: Size is your preference.

Cutting mat: Size is your preference

Pins

Seam Ripper

Small iron/ pressing surface (optional)
