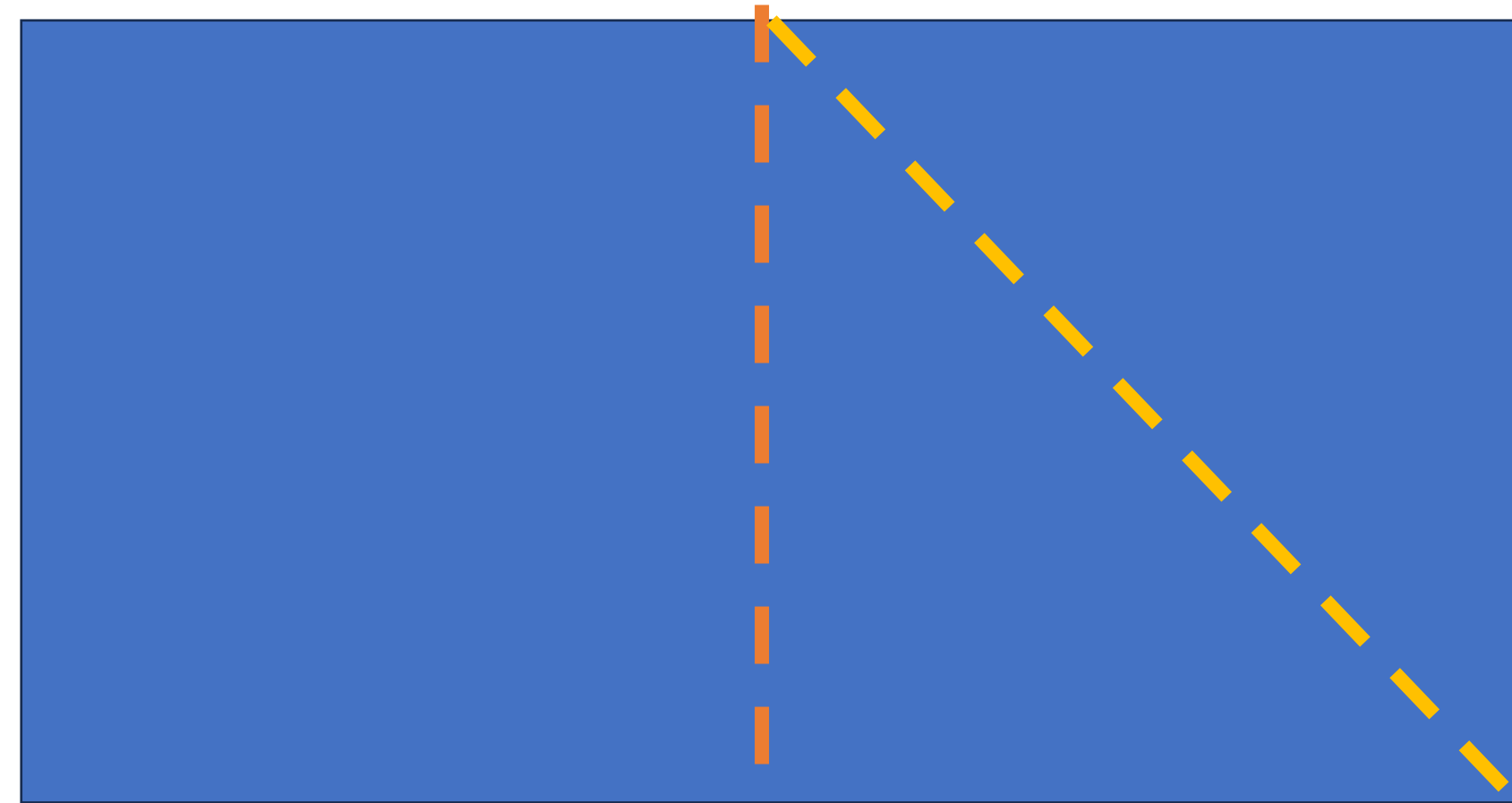


Use the Square Squared Tool to Trim the Peach Fabric to the Correct Size for a 6" Finished Square.

**Fold the Dark Blue Fabric in Half & Cut Two 4" Squares.
Cut Each Square Diagonally Once to Make 4 HST's**

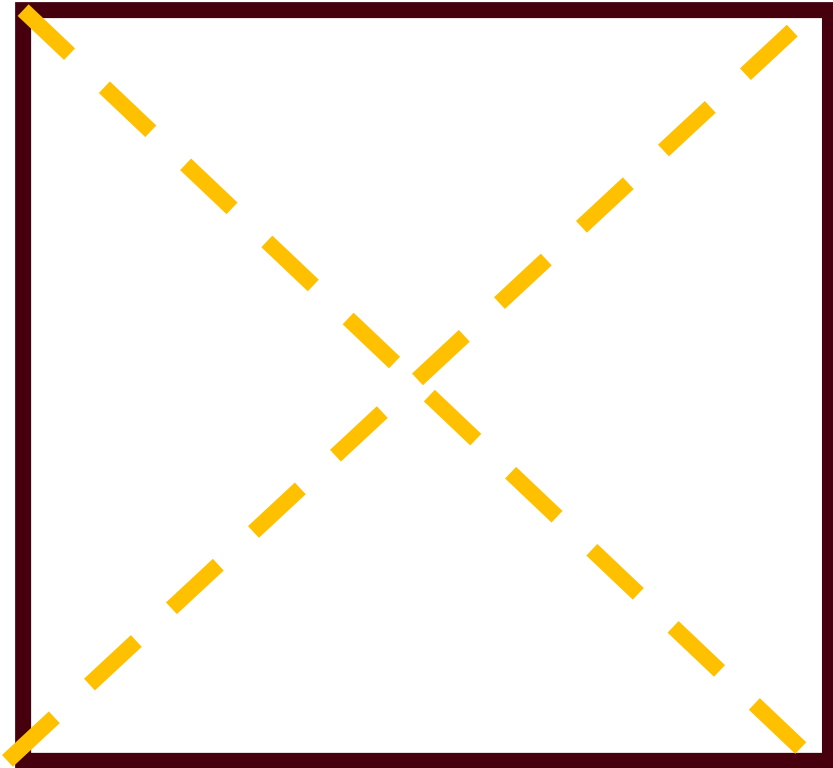




**Sew the Dark Blue
Triangles to the Corners
of the Peach Square.**

**Trim to 6-1/2" using the
Square Squared Tool.**

Make the Flying Geese. Cut the Background & Green Squares Twice Diagonally Like an “X”.





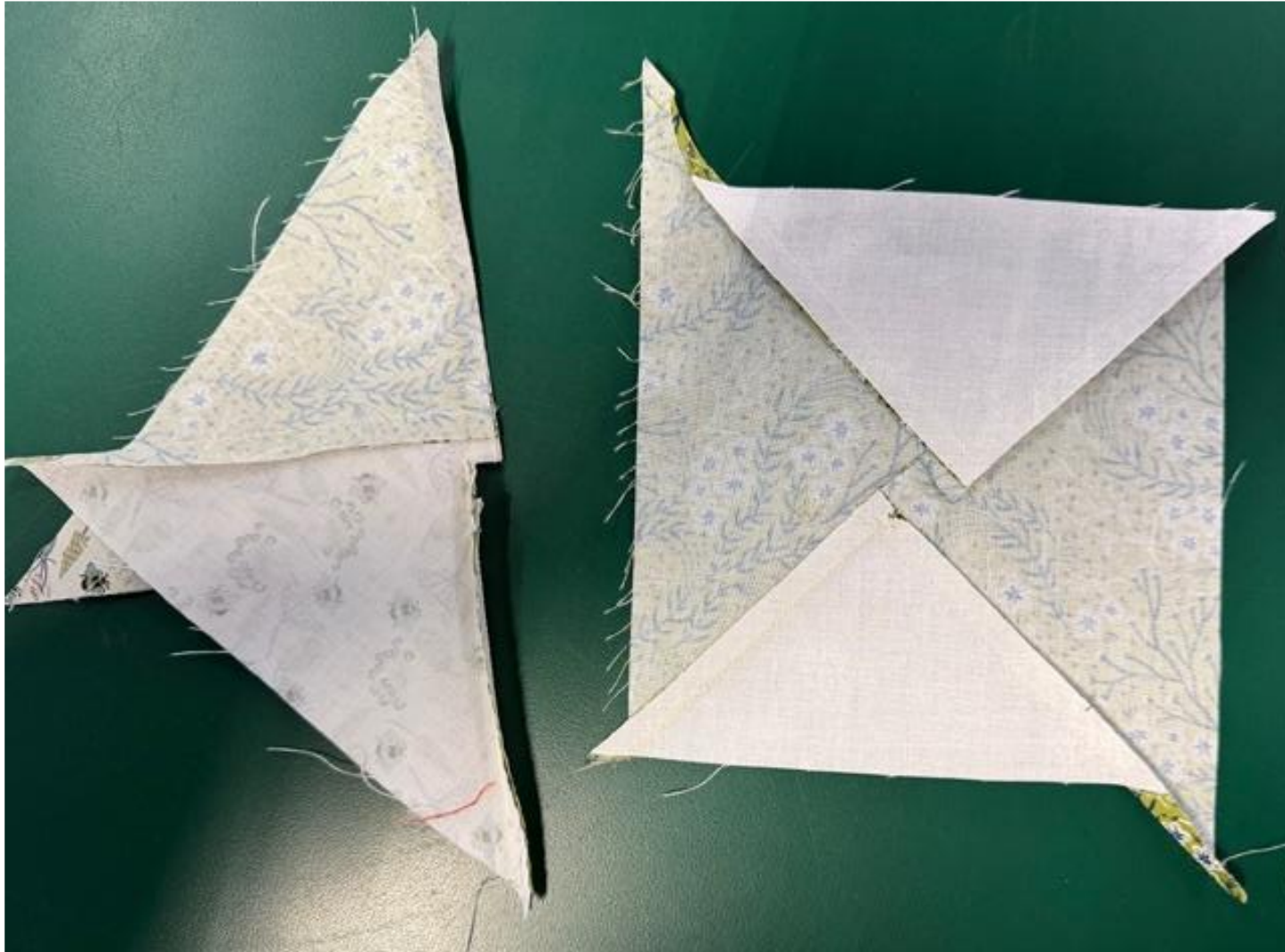
**Sew the Resulting QST
Triangles Together,
Matching the 90-Degree
Ends. The Green
Triangles Will be Longer
than the Backgrounds.
Press Toward the Larger
Triangles**



**Join the Triangle
Sets into Squares.**

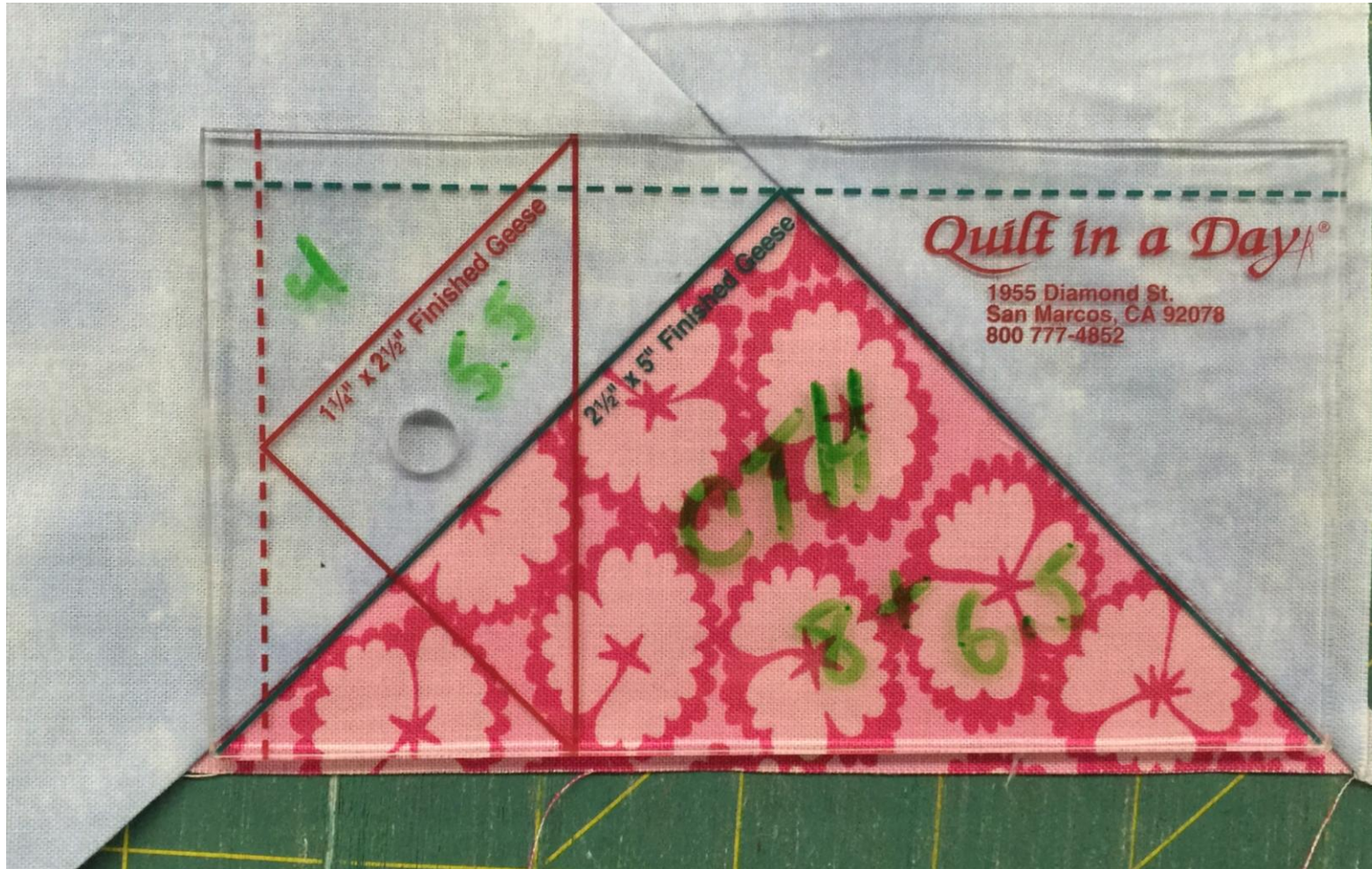
**The Center Seams
Do Not Match!**

**Fold the Unit in Half & Clip the Middle to Break the
Stitching in the Seam Allowance.**



**This Will Allow
the Squares to be
Pressed Flat,
Toward the Larger
Triangles.**

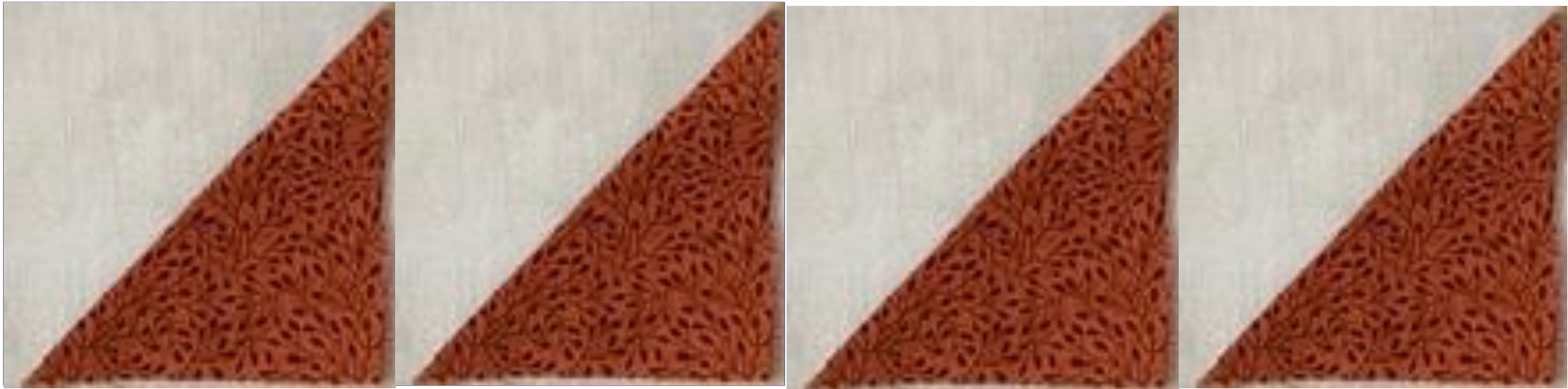
Use the QIAD 3x6 Flying Goose Ruler to Trim the Squares into Four Perfect Flying Goose Units. (Picture is for Technique Illustration Only)



Sew a Set of Flying Geese To Opposite Sides of the Center Square. Green Touches Blue.



**Layer the Orange Fabric With Your Background.
Cut Four Sets of 3-1/2" Half Square Triangles.
Stitch Together.**



Sew an Orange/Background HST Pair to Opposite sides of The Other Flying Goose Units, As Shown, with Orange Corners Facing Out. Make Two Rows





**Join Rows.
All Done!**
