



Beginning Quilting – Sawtooth Star (Quilt as You Go)

Date(s): Thurs, October 15th, 22nd, 29th and November 5th, 12th, 2026
Time: 10:00-12:00 OR 6:00-8:00

Fee: \$110 OR \$25 per session

Welcome to the world of quilt making. Learn to cut fabric using a rotary cutter, strip piece, quilt as you go technique, joining blocks, and binding as you construct this eye-catching saw tooth star quilt. Ask about attending a class or two to perfect your technique at various stages of the quilt making process.

Fabric Supplies:

- 2/3 yard of 3 different fabrics for the star tooth stars. Choose one focus fabric with pattern and 2 coordinating “blender” fabrics with texture or a small pattern
- 2 yards for backing, binding and joining your blocks
- Crib size batting (46” X 60”)

For the first class you should bring the following:

- Olfa Rotary Cutter (45 mm) and Cutting Mat (18” X 24” or larger)
- Creative Grids 8 ½” X 24 ½” Ruler
- Creative Grids 3 ½” X 12 ½” Ruler (Creative Grids Quick Trim and Circle Ruler is the same size and has extra features)
- Frixion Pen or other marking pen
- All your fabric pressed and ready to cut. Pre-washing fabric is a personal preference. Either way, press your fabric before coming to the first class. Lightly spray your fabric with Best Press (spray starch) prior to pressing. This will help get nice crisp cuts by stabilizing the fibers and helping to prevent distortion on bias edges.
- **YOU DO NOT NEED TO BRING YOUR MACHINE TO THE FIRST CLASS**

For the remaining classes, you will also need to bring:

- Sewing machine in top working order with extra empty bobbins
- New sewing machine needle (80/12 Universal)
- All purpose presser foot
- ¼” presser foot
- Walking foot (helpful when sewing through layers)
- Thread – neutral for piecing, color to match front and back of quilt for quilting
- Straight Pins/Wonder Clips
- Scissors
- Measuring tape
- Quilting Gloves
- 505 Temporary Fabric Adhesive
- Cut Rite Bind Up Tool (for class 5)
- Hand Sewing Needles (for class 5)
