

## Beginning Quilting A-Z

This is a wonderful class for anyone that has not done a complete quilt from start to finish, or someone that would like to know shortcuts or specifics about quilting. You will be starting off reading a pattern, picking fabric, making a label, putting on a sleeve and binding your quilt.

You need:

- Pattern: "Just Can't Cut It" by All Washed Up
- Pen for taking notes
- An idea of the colors for your quilt
- A presser foot and ankle from your sewing machine so we can have the appropriate ¼" and walking feet for your machine
- Roll of masking tape

Supplies will be added as the class progresses:

- Fabric and batting
- Threads: piecing, machine quilting, binding, Lt grey or off white
- Sewing machine in top running condition\*
- Presser feet: ¼" with guide, walking/even feed
- Needles: Universal 80/12
- Scissors: sharp thread snips
- Rotary cutter: medium (45mm) or small (28mm)
- Cutting mat: medium or large
- Ruler: 6 ½" x 24 ½"
- Plexiglas: 12 ½" x 12 ½" square
- Pins: Long Quilter's pins, small safety pins
- Seam ripper
- Marking tools: Frixion pen, Chaco-Liner Pen
- Small iron: optional
