

# Embroidery Club \$20/meeting or \$65/year (4 Meetings)

Stained Glass Block Monday, April 22, 2024 10 a.m.-12p.m. or 6-8 p.m.

Stained glass embroidery adds a touch of beauty to your window or add fairy lights or a tealight to the inside of the glass block to place in quiet corner of your room. You can add water and fresh flowers too!

## **Design Choice:**

<u>www.emblibrary.com</u> Search for <u>Stained Glass</u> then, click on **Projects.** Click on **How To Add Embroidery To Glass Blocks.** Print out the .PDF tutorial. If you scroll through the tutorial, at the bottom are suggested design blocks, but you can search the entire emblibrary website to see more choices.

Create a User ID and Password, purchase the design. Click: My Account / Order History / One-Click Download. Save to a USB stick.

Glass blocks come in three sizes. If you chose the 7.5"x7.5" glass block, choose a slightly smaller design size such as 7"x7" or 6.9"x6.9" so it fits with a little wiggle room. Likewise, if your glass block is 5.5"x5.5", choose a design size of 4.9"x4.9"

## **Supply List**

- Organza
- Embroidery thread (some designs have 17 or more color changes) be prepared
- Scissors
- Sew and Wash Water-soluble fibrous stabilizer
- Your choice of adhesive such as temporary spray adhesive, Velcro dots, double-sided tape, or E6000 Clear Transparent Permanent Glue
- Glass Block (Typically size 7.5" x 7.5", 5.5" x 5.5", and 3.5" x 7.5" from craft stores like Hobby Lobby, Michael's, and Amazon)
- Battery powered string lights or tea lights

You will need two layers of Sew and Wash stabilizer, and one layer of organza.

### **Embroidery Supplies Needed**

\*Embroidery machine, embroidery arm, 4x4, 5x7, 6x10, or 8x12 hoop, embroidery foot, power cord, etc.

Schmetz Embroidery 75/11 machine needle (CTH#1745)

2 Bobbins full with white bobbin thread, plus extras

USB stick with design loaded or saved into the memory of your machine

### PRE-CLASS HOMEWORK:

Print out the .pdf instructions. Make sure the designs are able to be loaded into your embroidery machine,. Note the time to stitch-out. A small 5x5 design took 90 minutes on my embroidery machine.
