Supply List

Quilting Supplies:

- Westalee Feathered Template Set (WT-FS4)
- 12" Feather Spine Template (WT-FSPINE12)
- Creative Grids or Quilter's Select Rectangular Ruler Approximately 3" x 18"
- 12" Arc (included in Starter Set)
- TruGrips
- Westalee Design Kit
- Westalee Design Spacing Gauge (WA-SPG)
- Westalee Free Motion Glider or Grid Glider
- Sew Steady Extension Table to fit your machine
- Mettler 50 wt. polyester thread in a color that slightly contrasts with your fabric
- Two Bobbins filled with the same thread
- Klasse ***Topstitch*** Needles, size 90/14 Needles
- Friction Marker
- Sewing Machine in Top Running Condition
- Ruler Foot Appropriate for Your Machine
- Sench Self-threading Needles
- 505 Spray Adhesive
- Mary Ellen's Best Press
- Fraycheck
- Standard Sewing Supplies (pins, thread snips, scissors, seam ripper, etc.)

Fabric Requirements:

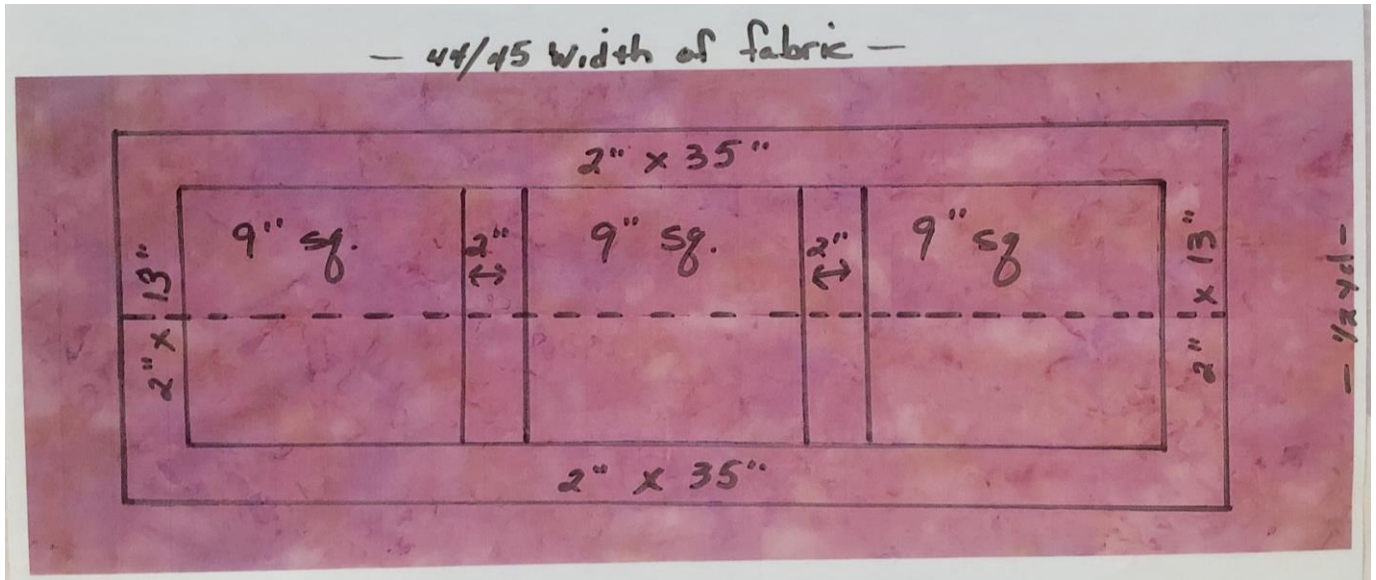
Prepare your Quilt Sandwich using the Instructions that Follow.

- 18 x 42" piece of fabric for the "top" of your quilt sandwich (1/2 yd)
- 18 x 42" piece of fabric for the "back" of your quilt sandwich (1/2 yd)
- 22 x 46" Piece of Quilters Dream Cotton batting

Instructions for Preparing The Quilt Sandwich Before Class



- Spray the top fabric with 3 layers of Mary Ellen's Best Press. Press Flat. Then fold in half lengthwise and press a center line.
- Before you sandwich, mark the top fabric according to the diagram. It's best to use a marker that will remove completely. We recommend Frixion markers for light fabric & Iron Off Miracle Chalk on darks.
- Draw a 35" long dashed line over crease selvage to selvage
- At each end of dashed line, draw a 13" line in the opposite direction
- Draw two 35" lines to create a Rectangle 13"x35"
- Draw one 9" square, 2" sashing, center 9" square, 2"sashing. You should now have a grid drawn on your fabric that looks like the one pictured. Do not trim away extra fabric on outside edges. That area will be used in class for practice stitching.
- Use 505 Spray Adhesive to Baste the Marked Top to the Batting.
- Repeat to Spray Baste the Backing Fabric to the Top/Batting.
- Stitch the outside marked lines with a thread color that slightly contrasts with your fabric. The other lines are used for placement when you stitch.
