



Free Motion Quilting

Are you tired of your same old straight quilting? If you want to become more comfortable and more proficient at Free Motion Quilting this is the class for you. We will start with an easy meandering stitch and build your skill level from there.

Supply list:

- Quilt sandwiches: these consist of two pieces of plain fabric and one piece of batting each about 12” square, I would suggest that you bring 6-12 sandwiches. (using a plain fabric will allow you to see your design as you quilt) The sample that is in the store is 20” square. If you want to do something similar bring that in also.
- Sewing machine, in good working order
- Schmetz Quilting needles-we sell a variety pack (CTH#402054)
- Scissors-small
- Threads-I used Superior Rainbow thread (CTH#110) on the sample, you may choose these or one of the following: Mettler Silk Finish (CTH#9105), a machine quilting thread or any of the embroidery threads (CTH#3406, #2596, or #40) that we carry. Make sure that you have a bobbin filled with the same thread that you are using on the top.
- Quilting gloves such as Machingers (CTH#5601031)
- 505 spray adhesive (CTH#200342)
- Presser feet-free motion quilting foot for your specific machine
- Optional but nice: Supreme Slider (CTH#89102141), Fabulous Fabric Glide (CTH#8910214)
