



Accuquilt Go! Qube Block Party Morning Star Contemporary Quilt

Date/Times: Thursdays, Sept. 23, Oct. 21, and Nov. 18, 2021
10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. or 6:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Fee: \$15 per class OR \$40 for 3 consecutive classes

Brief Class Description:

We will be making the GO! Morning Star Contemporary Quilt. This is a very striking two-color quilt using one of Accuquilt's newest dies. The finished size is 53" x 53".

The pattern is a free download available from the Accuquilt website. Search for GO! Morning Star under the patterns section. Here is a link: <https://www.accuquilt.com/go-morning-star-contemporary-quilt-pattern.html>. Please download it and bring a printed copy to each class.

It will not be necessary to bring your cutter to class. As always, we make a GO! Cutter available to use during class.

Accuquilt Die/Mat:

55556	GO! Morning Star die
55138	GO! Cutting Mat 6" x 24"
55017 or 55014	GO! Strip Cutter – 2-1/2" (Optional for cutting binding strips)

Fabrics/Batting:

Light color	Light Gray (in sample)	1-7/8 yard
Contrast color	Dark Gray (in sample)	2-7/8 yard
Binding	Dark Gray (in sample)	included in contrast color yardage
Backing	57" x 57"	3 yards (add ½ yard for long-arm quilting)
Batting	Throw Size 60" x 60" (CTH #1010671)	

Schedule by Class:

On **September 23**, we will be doing all of our cutting. Please bring a rotary cutter, ruler and mat. We will have several Accuquilt cutters available, but if you would like to bring your own, it would be helpful. You will not need a sewing machine at this class.

Pre-class work: (helpful but not required)

Light fabric:

For shape A: Cut 4 (four) 12-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips.
Sub-cut each 12-1/2" x WOF strip into 4 (four) 4-1/4" wide rectangles
Cut 1 (one) 12-1/2" x 18" rectangle

For shape B: Cut 1 (one) 5" x width of fabric (WOF) strips
Sub-cut into 5" squares.

Contrast fabric:

For shape A: Cut 4 (four) 12-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips.
Sub-cut each 12-1/2" x WOF strip into 4 (four) 4-1/4" wide rectangles

For shape B: Cut 2 (two) 5" x width of fabric (WOF) strips
Sub-cut into 5" squares.

On **October 21**, we will learn how to assemble the blocks. There are two different block designs. Please bring your sewing machine.

Homework: Make 4 light blocks and 9 contrast blocks, for a total of 13 blocks.

On **November 18**, we will assemble the completed blocks into the quilt top. Please bring your sewing machine.

Also, bring the following:

Sewing machine in top running condition*
Presser Feet: 1/4" foot for piecing
Needles: Universal
Scissors
Rotary cutter, 45 mm (CTH#8921115)
Rulers: Size is your preference
Cutting mat: Size is your preference
Pins
Seam Ripper
Marking tool, such as a Frixion pen
