



Paper Pieced Earrings

What could be better than eye catching earrings you made yourself! Learn the technique of paper piecing on a small scale. Eight little flying geese complete this colorful rectangular earring.

Fabric: NO YARDAGE REQUIRED. You will need scraps of up to eight different colors for the flying geese and a 3" strip of fabric for the background.

Supplies:

- Patchwork Earrings Kit (2 finishes available) (CTH# 101212)
- Carol Doakes foundation paper
- Craft Glue
- 60 weight Bobbin Thread (CTH# 11052)
- Microtex 70/10 needle
- Small sharp scissors
- Sewing machine in good working order

PRE CLASS WORK: Make several copies on the Carol Doakes foundation paper of the template in your pattern. Wind a bobbin with the 60 weight bobbin thread. You will be using this as your top thread as well. Replace your needle with a new Microtex 70/10 needle. Thread your machine with the 60 weight Bobbin thread. You may have to manually thread the needle as some threaders may not work with this smaller needle eye opening.
