## Pet Portrait

### You need:

- Photo of pet\*
- 2 sharpie markers (fine point and ultra fine point)
- Tracing paper
- Muslin the size of the enlarged photo
- Small sharp scissors
- Optional: photo light box
- Fabric: Requirements will be discussed during the first class. If you have stash fabric that you think will work for the color/shades to represent the various values in the picture bring them along. Background and boarder fabric size determined by your photo size.
- Odif 505 spray
- Aleene's original tacky glue
- Toothpicks
- Practice quilt sandwich (top, batting, back) for free motion practice
- Quilting gloves
- Batting: size of you project
- Thread: Matching your pets color. We like Mettler silk finished cotton.
- Optional: photo light box

### Pre- class work:

\*You need to select a photo of your pet that has good resolution so it can be enlarged. Enlarge the photo to approximately 12 x 15 and print in gray scale. You can enlarge photos in gray scale at Staples or Kathy has offered to enlarge the photo for you on her Rapid Resizer software. Please email her **at least 2 weeks prior to class** if you would like her to do that the sooner the better. Her email is [ks Carrollstudios@gmail.com](mailto:ks Carrollstudios@gmail.com). You will also need to bring a color picture of the pet to match color fabric.... Kathy uses her iPad in order to enlarge it to be able to zoom in on a certain detail if needed.

### Also, bring the following:

- Sewing machine in top working order (you must be able to drop your feed dogs to free motion)
- Presser feet: zigzag foot, free motion foot
- Needles: 80/12 universal or sharp (bring extra)
- Scissors: small
- Rotary cutter: 45 mm (we have mats)
- Pins: straight pins
- Seam ripper: Just in case
- Marking tools: Frixion or Chacoliner
