



## Fabric Wrapped Rope Basket

Make a multi-use trinket tray from rope to hold keys, jewelry, coins, wrapped candies, sewing notions and so much more.

### Supplies:

- 3/16" cotton clothesline (CTH#560493)
- Plastic Template (CTH#3119) for 5" circle cuts
- Fabric for bottom of bowl (measuring at least 5")
- Fabric to wrap rope (use one or more colors if desired). One WOF strip cut at 1 1/4" (press down one side of strip by 1/4") wraps about one row of your basket
- 1/4 yard Heat n Bond Lite (CTH#3521) or Steam-a-seam Lite 2 (CTH#5440)
- Pins and Wonder Clips (CTH#5608114)
- Scissors (small and large)
- Jeans/Denim Needle (CTH#402058)
- All-purpose glue (helps prevent rope from fraying when starting your basket)
- Thread that matches rope (and thread to match fabric, optional)

### Also bring the following:

- Sewing machine in good running order
- Sewing foot for zig-zag stitching
- Hot glue gun for finishing
- Rotary cutter
- Small iron and ironing pad (optional but nice to have)
- Seam ripper
- Novelty button that coordinates with fabric in bottom or bowl

**TO PREVENT TANGLING; ROLL YOUR CLOTHESLINE INTO A BALL BEFORE COMING TO CLASS. FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH YOUR ZIG-ZAG STITCH (this is the stitch we use to hold the basket together)**
