

Serge It! Table Runner

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You need:

Pattern: Serge It! Table Runner, downloadable for \$12.00 at www.gailpatrice.com

Fabric: (5) ½ yd. each coordinating fabrics for the runner. (A, B, C, D, E)

If you plan to repeat one fabric for two different areas (as seen on the cover),

purchase double the amount of that fabric.

1 1/2 yd. fabric for the backing (F)

Batting: 3/4" yard of Pellon 987F Fusible Fleece

Thread: Two (2) or three (3) colors decorative threads. Suggested: (12 wt. threads for flatlocking

and 12 wt. or 8 wt. to finish outer edges)

Three (3) serger cone threads – coordinating color

Optional: 2 yds each of (2) colors $\frac{1}{4}$ "- wide ribbon to weave through reverse flatlocking

1/8 yd ribbons for "basket weaving"

Pre-Class Work:

Cut fabric according to the cutting instructions on Page 2 of the pattern

Also, bring the following:

Serger in top running condition*
Presser Feet: Standard serger foot

Needles: Topstitch needle size 90/14 or 80/12

Universal needle size 90/14 or 80/12

Bodkin or yarn needle (dull point, large eye)

Scissors: sharp or thread snips

Serger Seam Ripper: For those mistakes we never make ☺
