You need:

Pattern: Cut Loose Press "Stained Glass Runner" by Kris Holderness
Fabric: As listed on pattern (you can substitute $\frac{1}{4}$ yard for fat quarters
Batting: As listed on pattern
Thread for piecing: Mettler polyester 9161 in medium gray
Thread for top stitching: Mettler silk finish cotton 9105 in coordinating colors

Also, bring the following:

Sewing machine in top running condition*
Presser feet: $\frac{1}{4}$ " with guide, walking/even feed
Needles: Universal 80/12
Scissors: sharp thread snips
Rotary cutter: 40mm
Pins
Seam ripper
Marking tools: Frixion pen

Pre-Class Work:

From black fabric (binding & framing fabric) cut:

3 @ 2" WOF (binding) *CUT FIRST
8 @ $\frac{3}{4}$ " WOF (framing)

From medium blue (center blocks & border rectangles) cut:

1 @ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" (block centers)
1 @ 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 19" (border rectangles)

From light green (block side & border rectangles) cut:

1 @ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" (block sides)
1 @ 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 19" (border rectangles)

From medium green (block & border corners) cut:

1 @ 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 22" (block corners)
1 @ 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10" (border corners)

From light blue (top background) cut:

1 @ 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
2 @ 5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
