## Tea Time Topper

Date(s) \_\_\_\_\_ Time \_\_\_\_\_

### You need:

Pattern: Tea Time by Rachel Shelburne and Darlene Zimmerman

Fabric:

7 Fat Quarters or  $\frac{1}{4}$ " yard of 7 fabrics

$\frac{5}{8}$  yd for borders and binding

$\frac{1}{2}$  yd for background

1 yd for backing

Crib size batting

1 yd Heat N Bond Light or Featherweight

Thread for stitching: Mettler 100% polyester in medium grey and a full bobbin

Thread for topstitching: Mettler Silk Finish Cotton in matching/contrasting colors or Sulky Blendables

### Pre-Class Work:

From background, cut:

1@8" strip then sub cut to 3@ 8" x 11"

1@5" strip then sub cut to 3@ 5" x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From 3 fat quarters or  $\frac{1}{4}$  yards set aside 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 " for tea pots

From 3 fat quarters or  $\frac{1}{4}$  yards set aside 3" x 5" for cups

From all 7 fat quarters or  $\frac{1}{4}$  yards cut 30 @ 2"x 2" and 2 @ 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from each fabric

### Also, bring the following:

Machine in top working condition\*

Needles: 80/12 universal

Feet: all purpose,  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", stitch in the ditch, walking/even feed

Rotary cutter: medium size with a sharp blade (we have mats)

Scissors: sharp small ones

Seam ripper

Ruler: at least 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Pins: Long quilting pins
