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Parade Rules and Procedures

1. APPLICATION DEADLINE: **MONDAY, JULY 21, 2018 by 5:00 PM**

2. **Entry Acceptance and Parade Placement** – The decision of which entries will be allowed in the parade and the placement of each entry within the parade shall be the decision of the Parade Chairman and the Parade Committee. The decisions of this body shall be final.

A) We hope you will join us this year for the fun and excitement at the Lindon City Parade. We look forward to receiving your entry form. Consideration will be given as to parade line-up order based on when entries are received. The entry deadline is July 28, 2017. **Please be sure to get your application in early!** Entries received after this date will be charged a \$25 LATE FEE if they are accepted into the parade.

3. **Controversial Material** – Material deemed controversial by the Parade Chairman or Parade Committee will not be allowed in the parade. An entry may be pulled from the parade as late as the start of the parade if, in the judgment of the Chairman or members of the Committee, the entry is deemed controversial, unlawful, or unsafe in any manner, or is otherwise inconsistent with the standards, theme, quality or purpose of the Lindon Days parade.

4. **Political Entries** – Political entries are not permitted in the Lindon Days parade. This includes candidates for office or their representatives, who may not participate as political entries in the parade.

5. **Confirmation Packet** – All applicants will receive a confirmation packet sometime after July 5 and before August 1st. This packet will include your parade number, map of the parade route, line-up & check-in details, etc. Please ensure you put the name & address you would like this packet sent to on your application. Please note: if the Parade is full or your application is denied we will notify you ASAP.

6. **Judging** – There will be no judging or awards.

7. **Dance, Drill and Marching Bands** - Need to have designed routines that have constant forward movement following their entry. This will avoid large breaks in the parade.

8. **Distribution**- The distribution of items along the parade route has become a serious problem. It has resulted in an increase in the amount of trash left along the parade route and more importantly has become a safety hazard for spectators. We want our Grand Parade to be FUN, but more importantly SAFE. Therefore, the distribution of advertisements, literature, candy, gum, treats or promotional items ON THE PARADE ROUTE may be done ONLY upon the following conditions:

Distribution Policy – Distributed items, including candy, may not be thrown to or in the direction of spectators, but must be handed to an individual. Distribution must not occur in any manner which encourages or rewards spectators that move from the viewing area (behind the fog line at the side of the road) into ANY PORTION of the street assigned to the parade route.

a) Candy should be individually wrapped.

b) We recommend entries who are throwing candy walk alongside the street to ensure the candy is thrown into the crowd, not into the street.

c) If participants are throwing from a vehicle, please ensure they are throwing the candy far enough away so that children aren't at risk by coming too close to vehicles or out in to the street to pick it up.

9. ATV's, Motorcycles, Golf Carts: Participants are welcome to include ATV's, motorcycles, golf carts with their entries, but please note:

a) Participants must obey all laws and regulations regarding motorized vehicles, failure to do so could result in a citation from local law enforcement and denial of any future parade applications.

b) We recommend participants wear proper safety gear.

c) Lindon City reserves the right to deny any entry we determine to be unsafe.

10. Water guns and water balloons: are prohibited.
