

Historic Preservation Commission Meeting Minutes

New Assignments: The Commission was informed that Councilwomen Randi Powell was given the assignment to be the new City Council liaison for the Historic Preservation Commission.

Review of the Christmas Tree Lighting: The Historic Preservation Commission and Lindon Parks and Recreation Department put on the Annual Christmas Tree Lighting on December 2nd 2019. Overall the event was a success and was well attended. Suggestions for next year include putting the hot chocolate outside so that people can have it during the event, using a tablet for the scripture reading to make it easier to see in the dark, and passing out candy canes earlier on in the program. The Commission also feels that having Santa attend is an important part of this event and should continue.

Scheduling dates for meetings in 2020: The commission decided to continue holding meetings every other month on the 2nd Thursday of the month. The dates for the remainder of 2020 will be March 12th, May 14th, July 9th, September 10th, and November 12th.

Events this year include Lindon Days from August 3rd to 8th and the Christmas Tree Lighting on December 7th.

Review of Public Survey Questions: Discussion on how to get more people aware of and attending community events. The Commission discussed questions that they will use in a survey to get ideas for future events and learn how to better promote awareness and attendance of these events. The Commission was given the task to meet with a variety of people in the city and ask them the survey questions.
