### UTA OFFERS FREE EXTENDED PARKING

In response to public feedback, the Utah Transit Authority is offering free extended parking as part of a one-year pilot program. Beginning July 1, UTA passengers can park their cars free of charge for an unlimited amount of time at most TRAX and FrontRunner lots. The pilot program includes Provo, Orem, American Fork and Lehi stations in Utah County. The pilot program is designed to help UTA riders conveniently connect to the Salt Lake International Airport.

Volunteers must be income eligible, be willing to serve 15+ hours per week and have the desire to help others.
