2017 Lindon Days Celebration - The Lindon Parks & Recreation staff as well as a group of wonderful volunteers, are excited this year to put on another great Lindon Days Celebration. Lindon Days kicks off on Monday, August 7th with the Lindon Days Car Show. The car show is always one of the highlights of the week with cars and participants coming from all over the State of Utah. It has grown from humble beginnings to one the State's largest free car shows.

Tuesday, August 8th, Lindon will celebrate the National "Night Out Against Crime" with the Lindon Police Department. There will be Q & A as well as police demonstrations. Come out and meet the Lindon K-9 officer Capone. Don't forget about the all you can eat ice cream and free outdoor movie Lego Batman. On Wednesday evening, our traditional Huck Finn Fishing event will be held at Creekside Park with awards for those dressed up like Little Abner and Daisy Mae.

2017 Lindon City Municipal Election

Lindon City is coordinating with Utah County to conduct the 2017 Primary and General Municipal Elections by using Vote by Mail, a system where all registered voters use absentee (Vote by Mail) ballots to vote. Each registered voter will be mailed a ballot and instructions for returning the ballot. Ballots for the Primary Election will be mailed out by Tuesday, July 25; and ballots for the General Election will be mailed out by Tuesday, October 17. **Please note that Lindon City does not need to hold a Primary Election due to the withdrawal of a candidate but will still vote for the Special Election for the 3rd Congressional District.** Ballots must either be returned by mail and clearly postmarked before Election Day or placed in the ballot box at the Lindon City Community Center, 25 North Main Street, Lindon, by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Ballots cannot and will not be forwarded by the postal service. All ballots that are determined undeliverable are returned to the County Clerk's office. If you have not received your ballot within two weeks after they are mailed, please call the Utah County Clerks Elections Division office at 801-851-8109 ex #5 or contact the Lindon City Recorder at kmoosman@lindoncity.org.

Public Works Pointers

Lindon has daytime watering restrictions to conserve our water resources. City policy is that outside watering is prohibited between hours of 10 am and 6 pm. First-time violators of this policy will receive a door hanger with a reminder of restrictions. Repeated violations may result in your irrigation water being turned off. Also, please be vigilant for cross-connections, such connections between the culinary and irrigation systems have the potential to contaminate the city's water supply. Thank you for observing these watering hours, and remember to turn



off your sprinklers if it's raining! Also, in order to prevent flooding, please make sure that our storm drains are kept free from debris. For any questions regarding possible cross-connections please contact our public works department at 801-796-7954. [2016 Drinking Water Quality Report](#)

August: The Recycling Facts about Aluminum



Aluminum cans are one of the most used items in the United States. They are also one of the easiest items to recycle. Check out these facts about aluminum and make sure to put your empty aluminum cans in your blue bin. Remember

there is no need to rinse out your soda cans—just toss them into your recycle bin.

- **Americans throw away enough aluminum to rebuild the entire commercial air fleet every three months!**
- **If an aluminum can is not recycled it will take up to 500 years to fully degrade in a landfill.**
