

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is the address of the Lindon Cemetery?

A. The approximate address of the Lindon Cemetery is 555 N 200 E

Q. How do I pick out a lot(s) (plots)?

A. You can go directly to the Public Works Bldg. located at 946 W Center St. between the hours of 7 am and 3:00 pm Monday thru Friday and choose your lot(s) off the cemetery map or you can contact Public Works and they can email you a map which you can take with you up to the cemetery and look around before coming into the office to purchase your lots.

Q. Does the City allow double depth burials?

A. No. Due to safety issues, the city does not allow double depth burials.

Q. When does the additional cost take effect for interment?

A. The additional fee will be charged for any interment on Saturday or if a funeral service begins later than 12:30 pm on weekdays.

Q. Do I have to pay for the lot in full at time of purchase?

A. There is an option to finance the purchase of Burial Rights for up to 2 years with an 8.0% annual interest charge. Burial Rights must be paid for in full before burial.

Q. How is an infant or baby burial different than an adult burial?

A. You can purchase either a full-sized lot and use one half to bury an infant, or you can purchase in the cremation area (half size lots). All lots (full or half) can only contain 1 headstone per lot. The interment cost is less than an adult.

Q. Where can I purchase a headstone?

A. You may purchase the headstone from the monument company of your choice. They will place the headstone on the lot. If you are purchasing a stone from the Veteran's Administration, you will be responsible to find a monument company to set the stone.

Q. If someone takes items from the grave, what can we do?

A. If items are lost, stolen or discarded from a burial site, Lindon City is not responsible. We discourage leaving special mementos or items of any value. Please see the city code 8.32.160

Q. Can an urn be placed in someone else's casket?

A. An urn can be placed in a casket at time of burial only. Once a burial has taken place, we do not reopen a lot to place an urn on top of an existing casket.
