

January 11, 2018 Minutes – Lindon Historic Preservation Commission

Approval of minutes – November 9, 2017 meeting: Motion by Rich Doxey to approve the minutes as written. Motion seconded by Connie Lamoreaux. Minutes approved 5-0.

Review – Lyle Lamoreaux welcomed everyone and indicated that Maxine Smith is excused tonight (Temple) but has recently been helping with "How I came to Lindon."
