

Parks, Arts, Recreation, and Culture (PARC)

The Mayor and City Council have approved a resolution to place a question on the Nov. 5th ballot for voters to consider approval of a 0.1% increase to the Lindon sales and use tax (1¢ for every \$10 spent in Lindon) for funding of recreational and cultural facilities and cultural organizations within Lindon. The resolution approval simply places the question on the ballot. A majority of voters will need to vote in favor of the issue in order for the tax to be approved. The tax revenue will primarily be used for funding of recreational and cultural facilities owned by the City, and potentially used as grant funding of other non-profit cultural organizations with a heavy presence in Lindon. The proposed tax is being referred to as the *Parks, Arts, Recreation, and Culture (PARC)* tax.
