

Swim Coach

Starting Pay Rate: \$10.65/hr

NATURE OF THE WORK

Under close supervision of the Park and Recreation Director and LAC Management, coach individuals and groups regarding the summer swim team program and activities for the facility; explains and demonstrates proper use of equipment; instructs participants in proper swimming techniques; observes participants and provide corrective feedback; organizes and conducts swim meets and competitions.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

- Prepares and administers daily practices.
- Supervise the participants and interact with parents/guardians.
- Participate and organize swim meets both away and at home.
- Prepare the pool for practice and assist in setting up for general public use.
- Maintain accurate records and files for the team members and facility.
- Supervise Assistant Coaches and ensure their good standing at work.
- Performs related duties as required.

Minimum Qualifications

- High school graduate or equivalent, college student or graduate preferred.
- Minimum of three (3) years of experience in competitive swimming or swim instruction.

Requirements

- CPR for the Professional Rescuer and Community First Aid certification
- Prefer American Red Cross Lifeguard Training and Water Safety Instructor.
- Ability to work mornings, mid-day, evenings, weekends, and holidays as needed.
- Will be subjected to a drug test and background test before employment.
