Nature of Work

Under close supervision of the LAC Management and Aquatic Supervisor plans, organizes, and provides quality swimming and water safety instruction.

Example of Duties

- Plans and organizes personal swim class outlines, methods and goals that support the general teaching outlines provided by the American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor program.
- Organizes and directs activities of assigned students in order to provide a high level of quality instruction for all students.
- Teaches the student on a personalized basis in meaningful instruction for the duration of class.
- Provides appropriate certificates and awards as the session concludes.
- Establishes positive public relations with parents/guardians of class students, helping them recognize and understand swimming developments and achievements.
- Enforce pool safety standards and facility operation rules for all individuals using the facilities.
- Help organize and assist in development of special programs, activities or instruction.
- Performs related duties as required.

Education and Experience

- Must be 16 years of age
- High school graduate or equivalent or currently attending high school

Requirements

- Possess or ability to obtain American Red Water Safety Instructor Certification, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, and Community First Aid, or equivalent.
- Prefer American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certification.
- Will be subjected to a drug test and background test before employment.
