## From the Book Panel 36-In - White (A):

- Fussy cut (12) $61 / 2$ " squares, each centered on a block.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (B), cut:

- (4) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 461 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $2 " \times 39 "$ WOF strips.
- (8) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 32$ " WOF strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $11 / 4 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 4 " \times 8 "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} "$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ strips.

From the Speech Bubble - Red (C), cut:

- (1) $31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / s^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $4 "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $61 / 2 "$ strips.

- (1) $31 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Purple (G), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Words - White (H), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 2 "$ squares and
(2) $3 \frac{1}{\prime \prime \prime}$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Gray (I), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Starry Basics - Tangerine (J), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.
From the Element - Yellow (K), cut:

- (1) $31 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " x 4 "$ strips.
From the Houndstooth Basics - New Teal (L), cut:
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Teal (M), cut:

- (1) $1 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $1 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips and
(4) $1 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Character Tossed Allover - White (Backing), cut:
-(2) 47 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 47 " x 57 " back.

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Book Panel 36-In - White (A):

- Fussy cut (12) $61 / 2 "$ squares, each centered on a block.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (B), cut:

- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 " $\times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
- (6) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 " x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 461 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 39$ " WOF strips.
- (8) $11 / 4 " \times 32$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $11 / 4 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 4 " \times 8$ " strips.
- (1) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ strips.

From the Speech Bubble - Red (C), cut:

- (1) $31 / s^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) $21 / 2 " \times 4$ " strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Starry Basics - Lime Green (D), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Swirl - Teal (E), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Element - Gray (F), cut:

- (1) $31 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Purple (G), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Words - White (H), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 2 "$ squares and
(2) $31 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Gray (I), cut: - (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Starry Basics - Tangerine (J), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Element - Yellow (K), cut:

- (1) $31 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - New Teal (L), cut: -(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Teal (M), cut:

- (1) 1 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $1 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips and
(4) 1 " $\times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Border Stripe - Gray (N), cut:

- (2) $101 / 4 " \times 73 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $101 / 4 " \times 62 "$ LOF strips.

From the Character Tossed Allover - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) $66 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66 " x 77 " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 $1 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $91 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure $8 " \times 8 "$. Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) $1 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to each side of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric H square. Sew (1) 1" x $41 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric H square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.
3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 square.

4. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 8 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) 8" Unit 4 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 square.

5. Sew together (1) $31 / 8 "$ Fabric C square, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ Fabric B strip and (1) $31 / 8 /$ Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row.
6. Sew together (1) $31 / 8 "$ Fabric K square, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 31 / 8 "$ Fabric B strip and (1) $3^{1 / 8 \prime}$ " Fabric H square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.
7. Sew together the top row from Step 5, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip and the bottom row from Step 6, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) $61 / 2$ " Unit 5 square (Fig. 5).

8. Repeat Steps 5-7 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Unit 6 square. 9. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the
Unit 5 square. Sew (1) $1^{1 / 4 "} \times 8$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) 8 " Unit 7 square.
10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 61 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 6 square. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 8 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 square to make (1) 8 " Unit 8 square.

11. Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 8$ " Fabric B strip to each end of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 32$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Block One strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Block One strip.

12. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 4 square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 8$ " Fabric B strip to each end of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 32 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Block Two strip (Fig. 10).

13. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 8 square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 8 "$ Fabric B strip to each end of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) $11 / 4 "$ x 32 " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 11).

14. Sew together (9) assorted $2 \frac{1}{2} " \times 4$ " strips end to end to make Row Two (Fig. 12). Repeat to make Row Four and Row Six.
15. Follow Figure 12 and sew together (1) Block One strip, Row Two, (1) Block Two strip, Row Four, (1) Block Three strip, Row Six and (1) Block One strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the $32 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Center Block.

16. Refer to Figure 13 and sew together end to end (12) assorted $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips to make the Left Side Border.
17. Repeat Step 16 and refer to Figures 14 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border.
18. Refer to Figure 15 and sew together (9) assorted $21 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips end to end. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric L squares to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

## Version \#1 Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Version \#1 Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

19. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
20. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
21. Sew (1) $2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 39" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make Version 1 of the quilt top.
22. Layer and quilt as desired.
23. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 \gg \times$ WOF Fabric M strips together end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
24. Bind as desired.


Version \#2 Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Version \#2 Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
19. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
20. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

21. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 39 " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
22. Center (1) $101 / 4 " \times 73 "$ Fabric N strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
23. Repeat Step 22 to sew (1) $101 / 4 " \times 62 "$ Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 16).
24. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 16), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make Version 2 of the quilt top.

25. Layer and quilt as desired.
26. Sew the (7) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric M strips together end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
27. Bind as desired.
