-(10) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (160) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Stone (B), cut:
-(4) $21 / 4 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $21 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $21 / 4 " x$ 11" strips.
From the Starry Basics - Light Gray (C), cut:

- (3) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 4 " \times 9 "$ strips.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (D), cut:
- (1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 9 "$ strips.
-(4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x 11" strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Orange (I), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and

-(1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

-(3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 11 "$ strips.
From the Starry Basics - Lime Green (X), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $1 \frac{1}{2} "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Green (Y), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 53 "$ strips.

- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Green (Z), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (AA), cut:
-(1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Bubble Dot Basics - Gray (BB), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $1 \frac{1}{2} "$ squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Black (CC), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Starry Basics - Black (DD), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Dot Basics - Black (EE), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Dot Basics - Purple (FF), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Plaid Basics - Purple (GG), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Muted Purple (HH), cut: - (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Starry Basics - Muted Purple (II), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Light Teal (JJ), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Bubble Dot Basics - Navy (KK), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Bubble Dot Basics - Red (LL), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $1 \frac{1}{2} "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Red (MM), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Starry Basics - Red (NN), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Red (OO), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Starry Basics - Teal (PP), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Houndstooth Basics - Light Gray (QQ), cut:
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{4} " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 4 " x 9 "$ strips.
From the Bias Plaid Basics - Charcoal (RR), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 55 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Teal (SS), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Light Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $56 " \times 67 "$ back.


## Quilt 1

Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) $27 / 8 "$ Fabric E square on top of (1) $27 / 8 "$

Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $21 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-12 for fabric identification and placement to make (8) of each unit square for Unit 2 through Unit 10.

3. Place (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric H square on the left side of (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 13). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 13). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 14).

4. Place (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric G square on the right side of the $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 21 / 2$ " Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 15). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 15). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 16).
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make
(8) Unit 11 strips total.

7. Sew (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric A square to the left end of (1) Unit 12 strip to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square lengthwise to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 31 square (Fig. 36). Repeat to make (4) Unit 31 squares total.

9. Sew (1) Unit 31 square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip and (1) Unit 32 square together in that order from the left to the right to make the top row (Fig. 56). Repeat to make the bottom row.
10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to each side of (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to make the middle row (Fig. 56).
11. Sew the (3) rows from Steps 9-10 together lengthwise to make (1) $71 / 2$ " Unit 51 square (Fig. 56).

12. Repeat Steps 9-11 to make a second Unit 51 square.

## Quilt 1

14. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 51 square. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 11$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 51 square to make (1) 11 " Block One square (Fig. 66).
15. Repeat Step 14 and refer to Figures 67-75 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each Block square for Block Two through Block Ten.

16. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 52 square. Sew (1) $1^{1 / 4 " x}$ 9" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 52 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 9 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the newly sewn block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 11 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn block to make (1) 11" Block Eleven square (Fig. 76).
17. Repeat Step 16 and refer to Figures 77-85 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each Block square for Block Twelve through Block Twenty.

18. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Eleven square, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Twelve square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 86).
19. Repeat Step 18 and refer to Figure 86 for component identification and placement to make Row Two through Row Five.
20. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 18-19, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $421 / 2 " \times 53 "$ Center Block (Fig. 86).

## Quilt 1

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 21. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 53 "$ Fabric Y strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric Y strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
22. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 55 "$ Fabric RR strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric RR strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
23. Layer and quilt as desired.
24. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric DD strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
25. Bind as desired.


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
