## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - White (A), cut:

- (5) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (100) $13 / 4$ " squares.
- (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 38$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 401 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Light Gray (B), cut: -(6) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (100) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Starry Basics - Light Gray (C), cut: -(6) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (100) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Light Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" squares.
- (1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Navy (E), cut:

- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 " squares.
- (1) $21 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
- (5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Gray (F), cut:

- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Charcoal (G), cut:
-(1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Purple (H), cut:

- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $3 "$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bias Plaid Basics - Purple (I), cut:
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" squares.
-(1) $21 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bubble Dot Basics - Red (J), cut:
-(1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Rose (K), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Green (L), cut:

- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" squares.
- (1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Green (M), cut:

- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" squares.
-(1) $21 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bubble Dot Basics - Navy (N), cut:
- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $3 "$ squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
-(5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Bias Plaid Basics - Teal (O), cut:
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Tan (P), cut:

- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" squares
-(1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bias Plaid Basics - Light Brown (Q), cut:
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" squares.
- (1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Orange (R), cut:
-(1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $3 "$ squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Yellow (S), cut:

- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Rose (T), cut:
-(1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $3 "$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bias Plaid Basics - Red (U), cut:

- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" squares and (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bubble Dot Basics - Black (V), cut:
- (1) 3 " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Gray (W), cut:

- (1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares and (8) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bubble Dot Basics - Yellow (X), cut:
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Bias Plaid Basics - Orange (Y), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
From the Bias Plaid Basics - Stone (Z), cut:
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (88) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Starry Basics - Light Gray (Backing), cut:
-(2) $56 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $56 "$ x $56 "$ back.

Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) $2 \frac{1}{8} "$ Fabric D square on top of (1) $21 / 8 "$

Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $13 / 4 "$ square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-42 for fabric identification and placement to make the designated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 40. Note: There will be a total of (400) unit squares for Unit 1 through Unit 40.

3. Sew (1) 3" Fabric D square to the left side of (1) 3" Fabric E square to make the top row. Sew (1) 3 " Fabric E square to the left side of (1) 3" Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $51 / 2$ " Unit 41 square (Fig. 43). Repeat to make (3) Unit 41 squares total.

5. Follow Figure 53 and sew together (4) $13 / 4$ " Fabric A squares, (4) Unit 1 squares, (4) Unit 2 squares, (4) Unit 3 squares, (4) Unit 4 squares and (1) Unit 41 square to make (1) 8 " Block One square. Repeat to make (3) Block One

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 54-62 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the designated number Block squares for Block Two through Block Ten. Note: There will be (25) Block squares total for Block One through Block Ten.

7. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 63).
8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 63 for component identification and placement to make Row Two through Row Five.
9. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 7-8, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $38^{\prime \prime} \times 38$ " Center Block (Fig. 63).

10. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric $Z$ square on the left side of (1) 2 $1 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric N strip, right sides together (Fig. 64). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 64). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 65).

11. Place another $21 / 2 "$ Fabric $Z$ square on the right side of the $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric $N$ strip, right sides together (Fig. 66). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 66). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 51 strip (Fig. 67).
12. Repeat Steps $10-11$ to make (44) Unit 51 strips total.

13. Sew together (11) Unit 51 strips end to end to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 68).
14. Sew together (11) Unit 51 strips end to end to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 69).

15. Sew together (11) Unit 51 strips end to end. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric $U$ square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 70 below).
16. Sew together (11) Unit 51 strips end to end. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric $U$ square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 71 below).

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 17. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 38^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric Y strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric Y strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric $X$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric X strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
20. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
21. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
22. Layer and quilt as desired.
23. Sew the (5) $21 / 2$ " WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
24. Bind as desired.


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
