


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

From the Word Blocks - Teal (A), fussy cut:

• (6) 6 ¹/₂" blocks.

- From the Tossed Flowers Dk. Blue (B), cut:
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 9 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 48 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 42 ¹/₂" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (C), cut: *Both Versions*

• (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips. *Version B*

• (5) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding for Version B.

From the Starry Basics - Green (D), cut:

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Blue (E), cut:

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 2 ¹/₂ strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Teal (F), cut:

- (2) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5 ¹/₂" squares.
- (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (G), cut: *Both Versions*

- (2) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 3 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ¹/₄" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
- (6) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (H), cut:

• (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Tan (I), cut:

- (2) 2 ⁷/₈" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 ⁷/₈" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (32) triangles.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Rose (J), cut: *Both Versions*

- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) small triangles. *Version A*
- (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ¹/₂" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) large triangles.

Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Cutting instructions are the same for both Version A and Version B except where noted.

From the Tossed Flowers - Red (K), cut: *Both Versions*

(1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" strips.
(1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) small triangles. *Version A*

• (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ¹/₂" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) large triangles.

From the Tossed Houses - Brown (L), cut:

• (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Lt. Teal (M), cut:

• (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Tossed Houses - Cream (N), cut:

• (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Tossed Houses - Yellow (O), cut:

• (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 2 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Red (P), cut:

• (5) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Tossed Flowers - Lt. Blue (Q), cut: *Both Versions*

• (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 7 ¹/₂" strips. *Version A*

• (1) 4 ¹/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ¹/₈" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) triangles.

From the Border Stripe - Lt. Blue (R), cut: *Version A*

(2) 7" x 52 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
(2) 7" x 42 ½" LOF strips.

From the Tossed Houses - Brown (Backing), cut: *Version A*

- (2) 63" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 63" x 73" back. *Version B*
- (2) 50" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 50" x 60" back.

Sewing Instructions


1. Sew (1) 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of (1) 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top of the sewn strip. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip to each side of the new strip to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 blocks total.

2. Sew (3) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" Fabric P strips and (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" Fabric J strips together lengthwise and alternating them to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 strips total. Unit 2 make 6 P J P J


3. Place (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square on the left side of (1) Unit 2 strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.




4. Place another 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square on the right side of the Unit 2 strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 6).

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (6) Unit 3 strips total.

6. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top of (1) Unit 1 block to make (1) Block One house (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Block One houses total.








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7. Sew (1) 2" x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (1) Unit 4 block (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Unit 4 blocks total.




8. Sew (1) 2 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 4 block to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (6) Unit 5 blocks total.



9. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O together, in that order, end to end to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (12) Unit 6 strips total.


10. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 block to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (6) Block Two rectangles total.



11. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (8) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric C strips and (16) 2 ¹/₂" Fabric E squares to make (8) Unit 7 strips (Fig. 12).


12. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (8) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric D strips and (16) 2 ¹/₂" Fabric F squares to make (8) Unit 8 strips (Fig. 13).

13. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (8) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric C strips and (16) 2 ¹/₂" Fabric G squares to make (8) Unit 9 strips (Fig. 14).



14. Sew (1) 2" x 2 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric H strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (8) Unit 10 strips total.


15. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip and (1) Unit 10 strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (8) Unit 11 strips total.




16. Sew (1) Fabric I triangle, (1) Fabric K small triangle and (1) Fabric J small triangle together to make (1) Unit 12 block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (32) Unit 12 blocks total.

17. Sew (4) Unit 12 blocks together to make (1) Unit 13 block (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (8) Unit 13 blocks total.

18. Sew (1) Unit 13 block to the top of (1) Unit 11 strip to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (8) Block Three strips total.


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Note: Skip Steps 19-20 if making the Version B quilt.

19. Sew (1) Fabric Q triangle, (1) Fabric K large triangle and (1) Fabric J large triangle together to make (1) Unit 14 blocks (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (16) Unit 14 blocks total.

20. Sew (4) Unit 14 blocks together to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (4) Block Four squares total.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

21. Sew (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block One house, (1) Block Three strip and (1) Block Two rectangle together, in that order, lengthwise, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

22. Sew (1) Block One house, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block One house and (1) Block Three strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

23. Sew the (4) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.

24. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make Version B of the quilt top.

Version A only

25. Sew (1) $7" \ge 52 \frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric R strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block Four square to each end of (1) $7" \ge 42 \frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric R strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make Version A of the quilt top.



26. Layer and quilt as desired.

27. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric G (Version A) or (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric C (Version B) strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

28. Bind as desired.


