

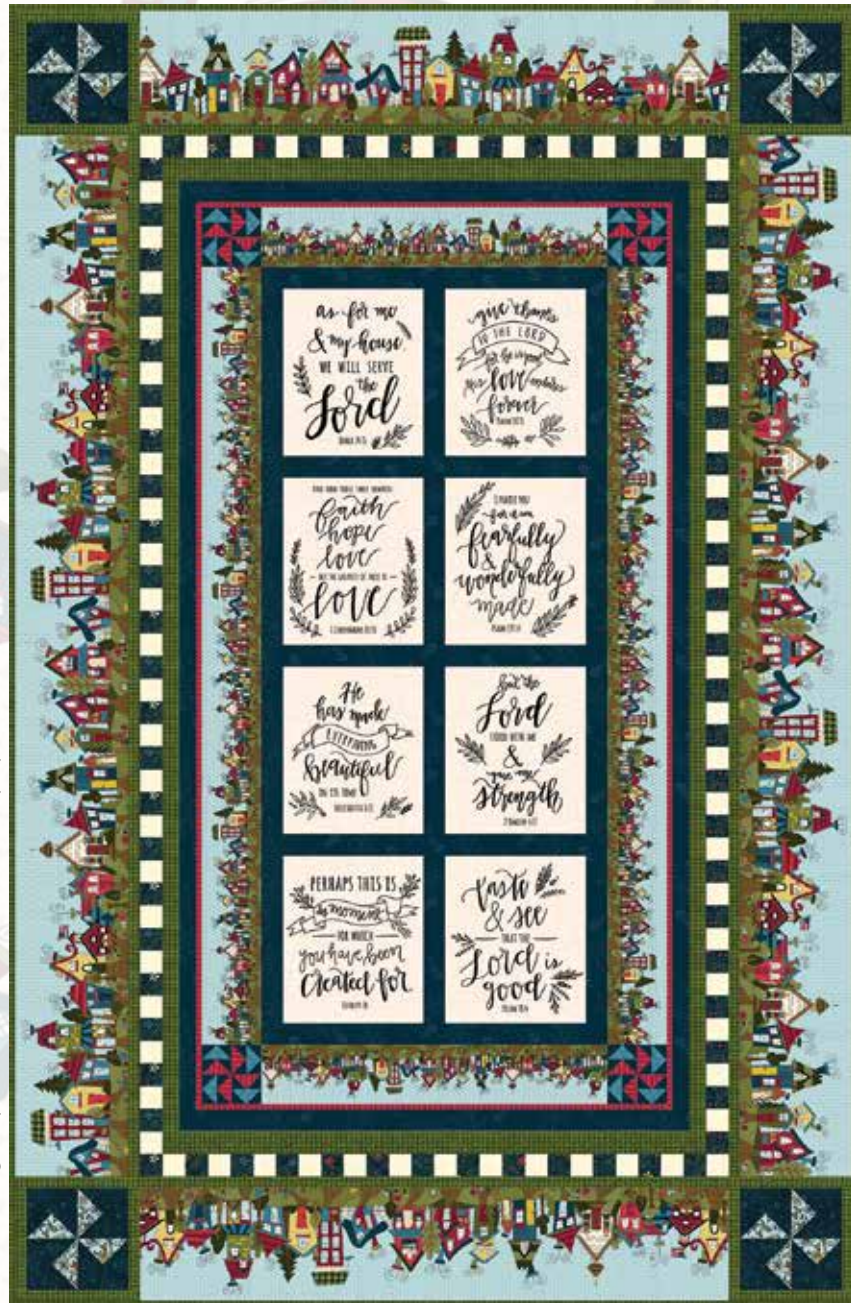

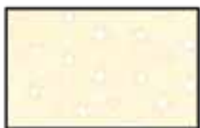

Materials

1 panel	Panel - Lt. Blue (A)	8888P-11
7/8 yard	Houndstooth Basics - Green (B)	8624-66*
1/4 yard	Starry Basics - Cream (C)	8294-04
1/4 yard	Tossed Flowers - Dk. Blue (D)	8892-77
1 3/8 yards	Border Stripe - Lt. Blue (E)	8889-11
1/8 yard	Tossed Flowers - Lt. Blue (F)	8892-11
1/8 yard	Starry Basics - Indigo (G)	8294-77
2 1/2 yards	Tossed Flowers - Red (Backing)	8892-88

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Lt. Blue (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 23" x 42 1/2" panel.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 26" WOF strips.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x 46 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 6" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 5" strips.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starry Basics - Cream (C), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (70) 1 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Flowers - Dk. Blue (D), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (70) 1 1/2" squares.

From the Border Stripe - Lt. Blue (E), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 46 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a row of words.
- (2) 5 1/2" x 26 1/2" LOF strips, each centered on a row of words.

From the Tossed Flowers - Lt. Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) triangles.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (G), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares and (8) 3 1/8" squares. Cut the 3 1/2" squares across both diagonals to make (16) small triangles. Cut the 3 1/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) large triangles.

From the Tossed Flowers - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 45" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 45" x 65" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 42 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

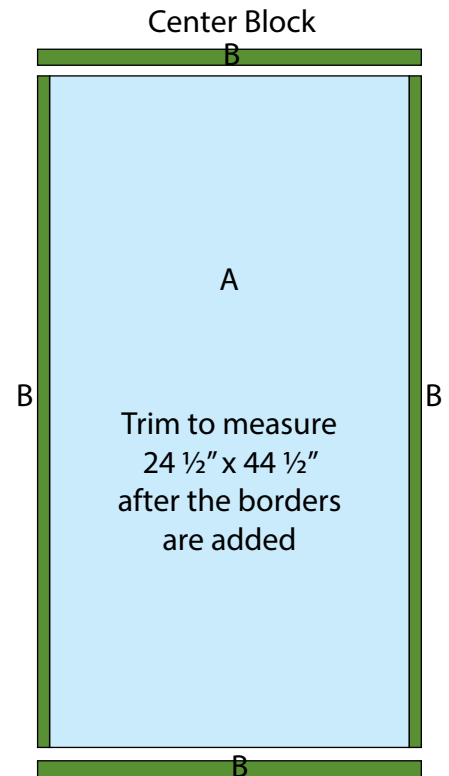

2. Sew (1) small Fabric G triangle and (1) Fabric F triangle together. Sew (1) large Fabric G triangle to the sewn strip to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 blocks total.

3. Sew (4) Unit 1 blocks together to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.

4. Sew (1) 1" x 5" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 1" x 6" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 Square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

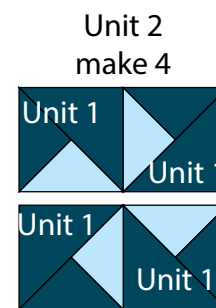

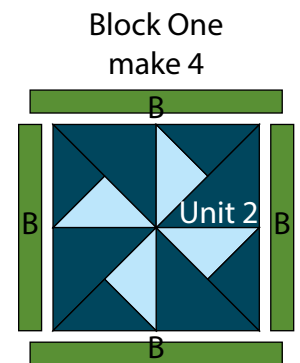

4. Sew (13) 1 1/2" Fabric C squares and (13) 1 1/2" Fabric D squares together, alternating them, to make (1) Top Inner Border strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (1) Bottom Inner Border strip.

5. Sew (22) 1 1/2" Fabric D squares and (22) 1 1/2" Fabric C squares together, alternating them, to make (1) Side Inner Border strip (Fig. 6 below). Repeat to make a second Side Inner Border strip.

6. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 26 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top of (1) 1" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) EB strip. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the EB strip to make (1) Top Outer Border strip (Fig. 7 below). Repeat to make (1) Bottom Outer Border strip. *Note: Pay attention to the fabric direction of the Fabric E strip as shown by the arrow in Figure 7.*

7. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top of (1) 1" x 46 1/2" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Side Outer Border strip (Fig. 8 below). Repeat to make a second Side Outer Border strip. *Note: Pay attention to the fabric direction of the Fabric E strip as shown by the arrow in Figure 8 below.*

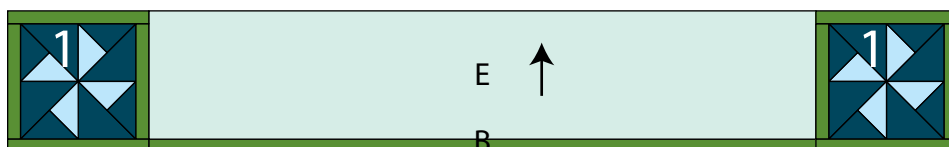

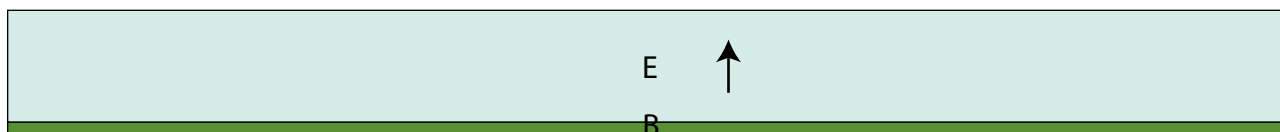

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

8. Sew (1) Side Inner Border strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Top Inner Border strip and (1) Bottom Inner Border strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) Side Outer Border strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Top Outer Border strip and (1) Bottom Outer Border strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

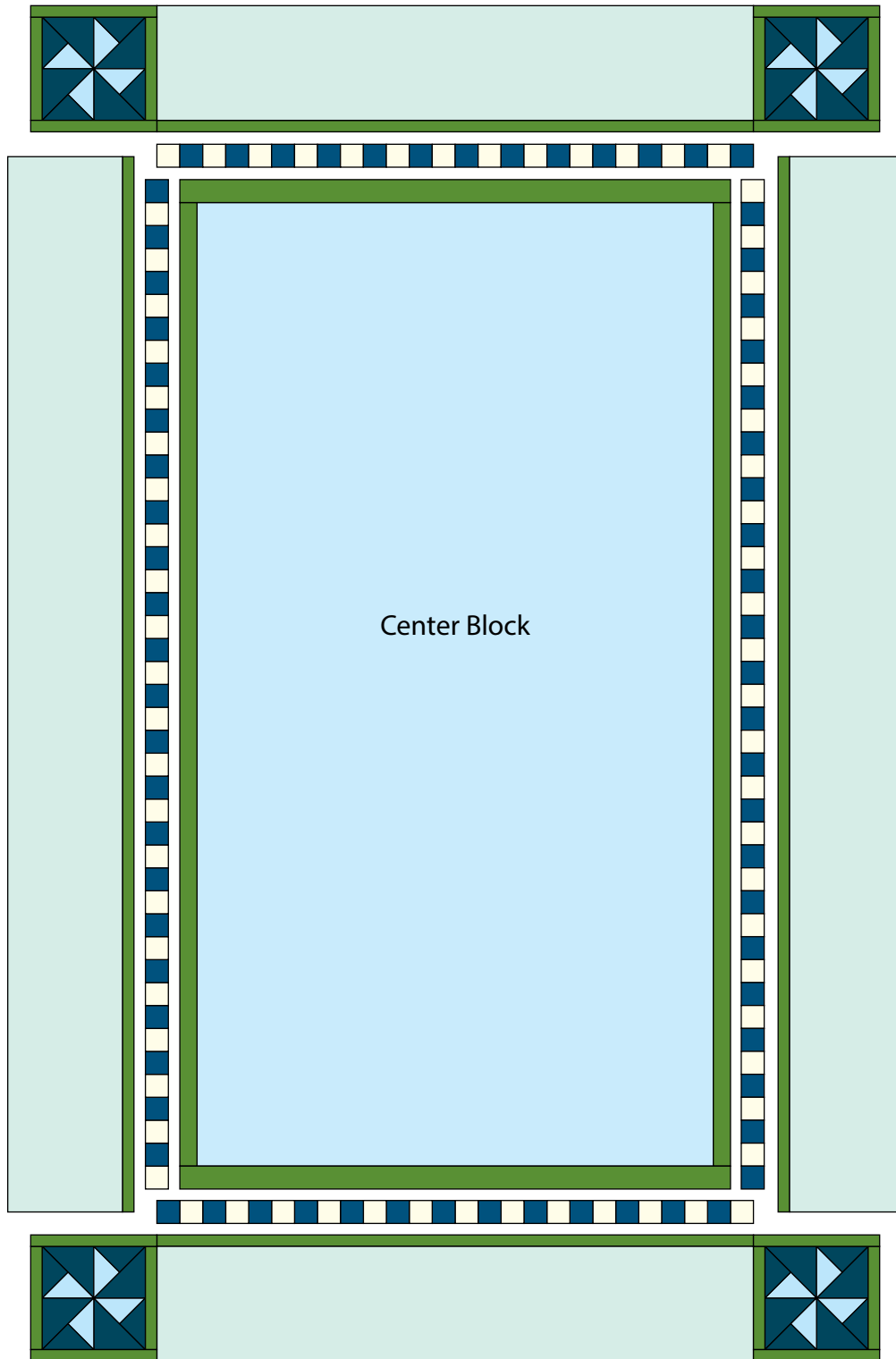
10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
