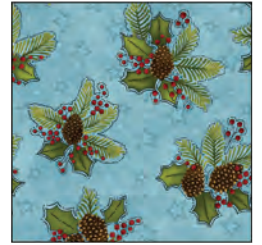

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Materials

1 ⅛ yards	Starry – Cream	8294-44
1 yard	Character – Red	8290-88
½ yard	Houndstooth – Gold	8293-33
1 ⅛ yards	Houndstooth – Green	8293-66*
1 yard	Holly – Red	8292-88
⅓ yard	Houndstooth – Red	8293-88
⅔ yard	Poinsettia – Red	8291-88
⅔ yard	Character – Green	8290-66
¼ yard	Poinsettia – Green	8291-66
3 ¼ yards	Poinsettia – Cream	8291-44 (Backing)

*Includes binding.

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Starry - Cream (A), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 4 ½" square and (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (80) 1 ¾" squares.
- (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (80) 1 ¾" x 3" strips.

From the Character - Red (B), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 4 ½" squares.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3" squares.
- (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (40) 1 ¾" squares.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Houndstooth - Gold (C), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 4 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 2 ½" squares.

From the Houndstooth - Green (D), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (32) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 1 ½" x 30 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 32 ½" strips.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Holly - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (36) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3" squares.
- (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (40) 1 ¾" squares.
- (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Houndstooth - Red (F), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3" squares.
- (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (40) 1 ¾" squares.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Poinsettia - Red (G), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3" squares.
- (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (40) 1 ¾" squares.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Character - Green (H), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 4 ½" squares.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Poinsettia - Green (I), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (32) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.

From the Poinsettia - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 56" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

2. Place another 2 ½" Fabric E square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance, to make (1) large EAE unit.

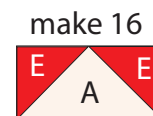

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (16) large EAE units total.

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4. Repeat Steps 1-2, using the fabrics listed in the chart below, to make the designated number of flying geese units:

(2) squares	(1) strip	# of units
1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric B	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" Fabric A	20 BAB units
1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric F	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" Fabric A	20 FAF units
1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" Fabric A	20 GAG units
1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric E	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" Fabric A	20 small EAE units
2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E	16 DED units
4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B	4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C	4 BCB units
2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B	4 ABA units

5. Follow Figure 5 and sew (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares, (4) large EAE units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square together to make (1) corner star block. Repeat to make (4) corner star blocks total.

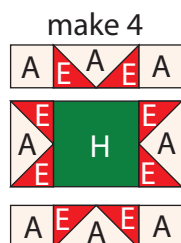

6. Repeat Step 5 using (4) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A square, (4) BAB units, and (1) 3" Fabric B square together to make (1) B Star Block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (5) B Star Blocks total.

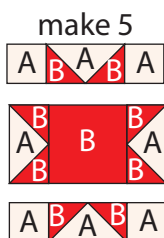

7. Repeat Step 5 (5) F Star Blocks, (5) G-Blocks and (5) E-Blocks total.

8. Refer to Figure 7 to sew together (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strips and (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips to make (1) Block One. Repeat to make (8) Block Ones total.

9. Refer to Figure 8 to sew together (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strips, (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strips and (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to make (2) Block Two. Repeat to make (8) Block Twos total.

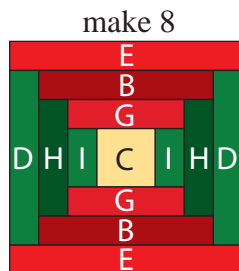

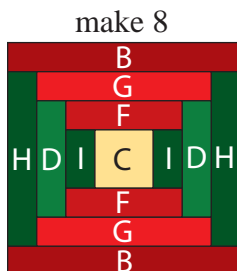

10. Sew (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares, (4) ABA units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square together to make the center square.

11. Sew (1) BCB unit to each side of the center square. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to each end of (1) BCB unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make the center block (Fig. 9).

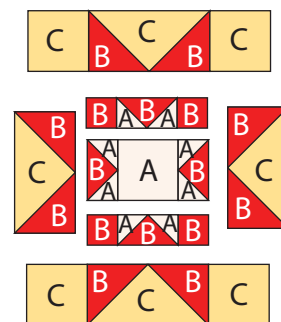

Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to Quilt Photo while assembling.)

6. Sew (4) DED units together, end to end, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make (4) strips total. Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each end of (1) DED strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the center block.

7. Sew (1) E-Block, (1) G-Block, (1) F-Block and (1) B-Block together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip (note the placement of the blocks differ). Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block. Sew (2) B-Blocks, (2) F-Blocks, (1) G-Block and (1) E-Block together to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the top of the center block.

8. Sew (2) E-Blocks, (2) G-Blocks, (1) F-Block and (1) B-Block together to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the bottom of the center block to make the quilt top.

9. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

10. Sew (2) Block Twos and (2) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the quilt top. (Note: The 2nd strip is turned 180 degrees.)

11. Sew (2) Corner Blocks, (2) Block Ones and (2) Block Twos together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. (Note: Blocks One and Two are switched in the second strip). Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
