## From the Calendar Panel - Green (A):

-Fussy cut (12) small panels, each approximately 7 " x $91 / 2 "$ for the small mini-quilts.

## From the Multi Dot - Brown (B), cut:

- (1) $5 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $5 " \times 16 "$ strip,
(1) $27 / 8 "$ square, (6) $23 / 8 "$ squares and (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strip.
-Cut (1) 1 " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 " \times 10 "$ strip and (1) 1 " $\times 71 / 2 "$ strip.
- Cut (6) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts


## From the Words - Green (C), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
-(1) $1 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $1 " \times 10 "$ strips.
- (1) 1 " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $1 " \times 7 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (3) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (1) $11 / 4 " \times 83 / 4 "$ strip.
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $21 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ strip.


## From the Character Toss - Teal (D), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) $31 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $31 / 4 "$ square,
(1) 1 " $\times 3 "$ strip and (2) $21 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Cut the $31 / 4 "$
square across both diagonals to make (4) triangles.
- (1) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $11 / 4$ " $\times 11 \frac{1}{4}$ " strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 10 \frac{1}{2} "$ strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 91 / 2 "$ strip and (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 83 / 4 "$ strip.

From the Houndstooth - Orange (E), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) $5 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $5 " \times 16 "$ strip,
(1) $37 / 8 "$ square, (1) $23 / 8 "$ square and (1) $1 " x 4 "$ strip.
- (1) $1 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 " \times 10 "$ strip and
(1) $1 " \times 7 \frac{1}{2} "$ strip.
- (1) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 11 \frac{1}{4}$ " strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2} "$ strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strip and (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} \times \times 83 / 4 "$ strip.

From the Starry Basics - Black (F), cut:

- (8) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 1 " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 " \times 10 "$ and
(1) $1 " \times 7 \frac{1}{2} "$ strip.

From the Starry Basics - Cream (G), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.

- See instructions to cut (81) assorted letters from (6) 3" x WOF strips.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $27 / 8 "$ squares and (8) $23 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the (2) $27 / 8 "$ squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) large triangles. Cut (6) $23 / 8 "$ squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) small triangles.
-(1) 2 " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 2 " squares and (4) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (H), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $61 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ strip and (1) $5 " \times 16 "$ strip.
- (1) $23 / 4$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (3) $23 / 4$ " squares and (6) $23 / 8$ " squares. Cut the $23 / 4 "$ squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles.
-(2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (33) $1 "$ squares, (1) $1 " \times 3 "$ strip, (1) $1 " \times 10 "$ strip and (1) $1 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strip.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $111 / 4$ " strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strip, (2) $11 / 4 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips and (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 16 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ strips.

From the Multi Dot - Red (I), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) $5 " \times 16 "$ strips.
- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $27 / 8 "$ square, (3) $23 / 4 "$ squares and (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strip. Cut the $23 / 4 "$ squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $111 / 4$ " strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 10 \frac{1}{4} "$ strip, (3) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 91 / 2 "$ strips and (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} \times \times 83 / 4 "$ strip.
-(1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) $1 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strip.

- (1) $14 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $12 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strip, (1) $37 / 8 "$ square, (1) $23 / 8 "$ square, (4) $11 / 2 " \times 13 / 4 "$ strips, (1) 1" $\times 4 "$ strip and (2) $11 / 4 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Words - Tan (L), cut:

-(1) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $6 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strip.

- (3) 1 "x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (66) $1 "$ squares,
(1) $1 " \times 10 "$ strip and (1) $1 " \times 7 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $11 / 4 " \times 10 \frac{1}{4}$ " strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 11 \frac{1}{4} "$ strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strip and (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} \times \times 83 / 4 "$ strip.


## From the Houndstooth - Green (M), cut:

-(1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into 5 " x $16 "$ strip.

## From the Houndstooth - Teal (N), cut:

-(4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.

- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5 " x $16 "$ strip,
(1) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square and (3) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 " strips and (2) $11 / 2 " \times 11 / 4 "$ strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (33) 1" squares.

- (1) $1 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) $1 " \times 10 "$ strips,
(2) 1 "x $71 / 2 "$ strips and (1) $1 " \times 3 "$ strip.


## From the Houndstooth - Rose (P), cut:

-(1) $5 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $5 " \times 16 "$ strip, (1) $31 / 4 "$ square, (3) $23 / 8 "$ squares and (1) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strip. Cut the $31 / 4 "$ square across both diagonals to make (4) triangles.
-(1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) $11 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $111 / 4$ " strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strip, (1) $1 " \times 10 "$ strip and (1) 1 " $\times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (66) 1" squares and (1) $1 " \times 2 "$ strip.

From the Multi Dot - Teal (Q), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.

- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5 " x $16 "$ strip,
(1) $21 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2} "$ strip, (1) $1 " \times 2 "$ strip and (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 91 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Starry Basics - Red (R), cut:

-(4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 30 "$ WOF strips.
- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $5 " \times 16 "$ strip, (2) $13 / 4 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 2 "$ strip and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ square.
- (1) $23 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) $23 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $11 / 4 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (3) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $101 / 2$ " strips and (1) $11 / 4 " \times 83 / 4 "$ strip.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 " \times 10 "$ strip and (1) $1 " x 7 "$ strip.

From the Character Toss - Tan (S), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $11 \frac{1}{4}$ " strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2} "$ " strip, (1) $11 / 4 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strip and (1) $11 / 4 \times 83 / 4 "$ strip.
-(1) $1 " \times 4 "$ strip.
From the Starry Basics - Orange (T), cut:
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (33) $1 "$ squares and
(1) $1 " x 4 "$ strip.

From the Starry Basics - Blue (U), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $27 / 8 "$ square and (3) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips, (1) $1 " \times 2 "$ strip, (1) $1 " \times 10 "$ strip and (1) $1 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strip.

From the Starry Basics - Tan (V), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $37 / 8 "$ squares,
(6) $23 / 8 "$ squares, (1) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strip and (1) $1 " \times 2 "$ strip.
- (2) 1 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (1) 1"x $10 "$ strip, (1) 1" x $71 / 2 "$ strip and (33) $1 "$ squares.

From the Starry Basics - Gold (W), cut:

- (1) $23 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) $23 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Mice Toss - Aqua (Main Quilt Backing), cut: -(1) $38 " \times 50 "$ strip.

From the Character Toss - Tan (Mini Quilts Backing), cut:

- (1) 8 " x $26 "$ strip.
- (4) 16 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 13 " x 16 " strips.
-(6) 9" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) $6 " \times 20 "$ strips.


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## Sewing Instructions

## Block One

1. Place (1) $23 / 8 "$ Fabric B square on top of (1) $23 / 8 "$ Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) HB units (Fig. 3). Trim the HB units to measure 2" square. Repeat too make (12) HB units total.

14. Repeat Step 1 using (1) $27 / 8 "$ Fabric $N$ square and (1) $27 / 8 "$ Fabric B square to make (2) $21 / 2 "$ NB units (Fig. 16).

32. Sew Block Four to the top of Block Five. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric P strip and (1) $11 / 4 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip together lengthwise to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip set. Sew (1) strip set to each side of the Block Four/Block Five strip to make (1) Block Six (Fig. 34).

34. Sew (1) $12 " \times 14 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric K strip to the top of Block Six. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top of (1) Block One. Sew this strip to the right side of the Block Six/Fabric H strip. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 18 "$ Fabric L strip to the top of this strip to make (1) Column Two.
35. Sew the (2) columns together to make the large quilt top.
36. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 36 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip to each side of the large quilt top. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 26 "$ Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the large quilt top.
37. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ Fabric R strip to each side of the large quilt top. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric R strip to the top and to the bottom of the large quilt top.
38. Layer and quilt as desired.
39. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric $Q$ strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
40. Bind as desired.
41. Add buttons to the Fabric L, Fabric K and Fabric H strips for hanging the month sign, monthly scene and the "Welcome" sign.

## Welcome Mini Quilt

42. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the required number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
43. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
44. Refer to Figure 36 to arrange and press the letters to spell "Welcome" onto the $41 / 2 " \times 22$ " Fabric O strip.
45. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
46. Layer and quilt as desired.
47. Sew the (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
48. Bind as desired.
49. Use Pearl Cotton or ribbon to make (2) loops that will fit over the buttons on the main quilt. Sew each loop to the top of the Welcome Mini Quilt for hangers.

## Monthly Mini Quilts

50. Repeat Steps 42-45 and use Figure 37 for Fabric identification and location to make (12) monthly signs.
51. Layer and quilt as desired.
52. Sew the (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF assorted fabric strips (as listed in Figure 37) together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
53. Bind as desired.
